FOREWORD

The data in this report is from 2019, before the Covid-19 pandemic. This data will be the base data against which fundraising performance during Covid will be compared. 2019 was also the year that saw significantly more information on fundraising performance being declared by those organisations filing accounts.

Combined with continued growth in giving in Ireland, at an international level, the per capita gap with the UK has now closed. When comparing giving on a GDP (Gross Domestic Product) basis a giving gap remains with our UK counterparts. Looking across the Atlantic, there still exists a giving gap on a per capita and GDP basis when compared to US giving.

Now, as our economy is in a different place, is it time to look giving levels more in terms of Ireland's giving capacity in terms of GNI (Gross National Income) and/or GDP and less in terms of per capita? GDP captures what our multi-national sector is contributing, and we see what this brings in terms of corporate tax income. Our entrepreneurial culture has advanced, wealth levels are rising.

At the same time, as a society, our preference is for access to world class public services. These need to be funded. Philanthropy can play a role. In this report we can see the role it is already playing in each sub-sector. What is its potential?

The unforeseen challenges and deep uncertainties experienced over the last almost 18 plus months continue to impact and will do so for some time to come. Collectively as a society we face testing times, as the full impact of the pandemic has yet to be revealed. The nonprofit sector has and will continue to play a vital role as we navigate the changing landscape.

Insights and data on giving are a critical resource to inform and guide the sector, including those seeking to support it. By building understanding of the giving landscape, collectively we can work towards optimising the raising of funds and their deployment for impact. Year on year studies is of key value, enabling trend analysis and contributing to a deeper understanding, of issues being addressed and what is being achieved.

Some findings in this year's report provide grounds for optimism. The increase in fundraised income is an obvious starting point, but the noted improvement in financial reporting augurs well; transparency is so important in giving. From a philanthropic perspective the small shift in the dial on major gifts, trust and foundation giving, and legacy giving as fundraising methods is positive. It is notable that they are also the most cost-effective methods tending to have a higher-than-average gift level. This highlights the value of strategic giving.

A dynamic giving culture signals a belief in civil society, recognising it as a vital contributor to the fabric of our communities and democracy. While this report draws on data that is pre-pandemic, it provides real insight on why the sector was well positioned for the resilience shown during the pandemic.

Well done to the team in 2into3 for developing this report and to those that have made it possible through their provision of resources. The insights here need to be used to guide and inform further development of giving in Ireland, visioning a model of strategic planned giving that supports the work of all organisations in the nonprofit sector for the benefit of society.



INTRODUCTION

2021 marks the second year of Giving Ireland but the 11th year of this report, formerly known as *The Irish Not-For-Profit Sector: Annual Fundraising Performance Report*. This report aims to narrow the gap in knowledge on the sector by providing an analysis of its composition, funding and benchmarked performance. It is our hope that Giving Ireland will be used as a platform to encourage debate, collaboration and action that will elevate the sector.

This report delves into the funding of the sector, looking at State, Earned, Investment and Fundraised income and exploring the implications of these trends.

2019 saw modest growth in the Irish nonprofit sector and a notable improvement in financial reporting standards, bringing Ireland's statistics on giving closer in line with its international peers. The gap between U.K and Irish Giving Per Capita and Giving as % of Income has narrowed considerably.

While uncertainties of a post-pandemic future loom overhead, it may also be said that we have more information than we have ever had on the true capacity and resilience of the Irish nonprofit sector. We must continue to seek solutions to obstacles to transparency and activating strategic, transformational giving in Ireland. The picture of the Irish nonprofit sector presented in this report offers hope that not only is this a realistic mission but that it is already underway. This is demonstrable in the anecdotal evidence of Irish nonprofits who have and continue to face the evolving challenges of the global pandemic and the uncertainties of a post-pandemic future. As the world adjusts to the shocks of 2020 and returns to a new equilibrium, the focus of the Irish nonprofit sector should be to pave a new path forward which builds on the sector's strengths, responds to pre and post pandemic challenges and exploits technological opportunities for growth and transformation that have emerged since.

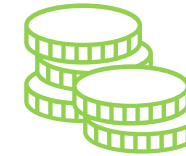

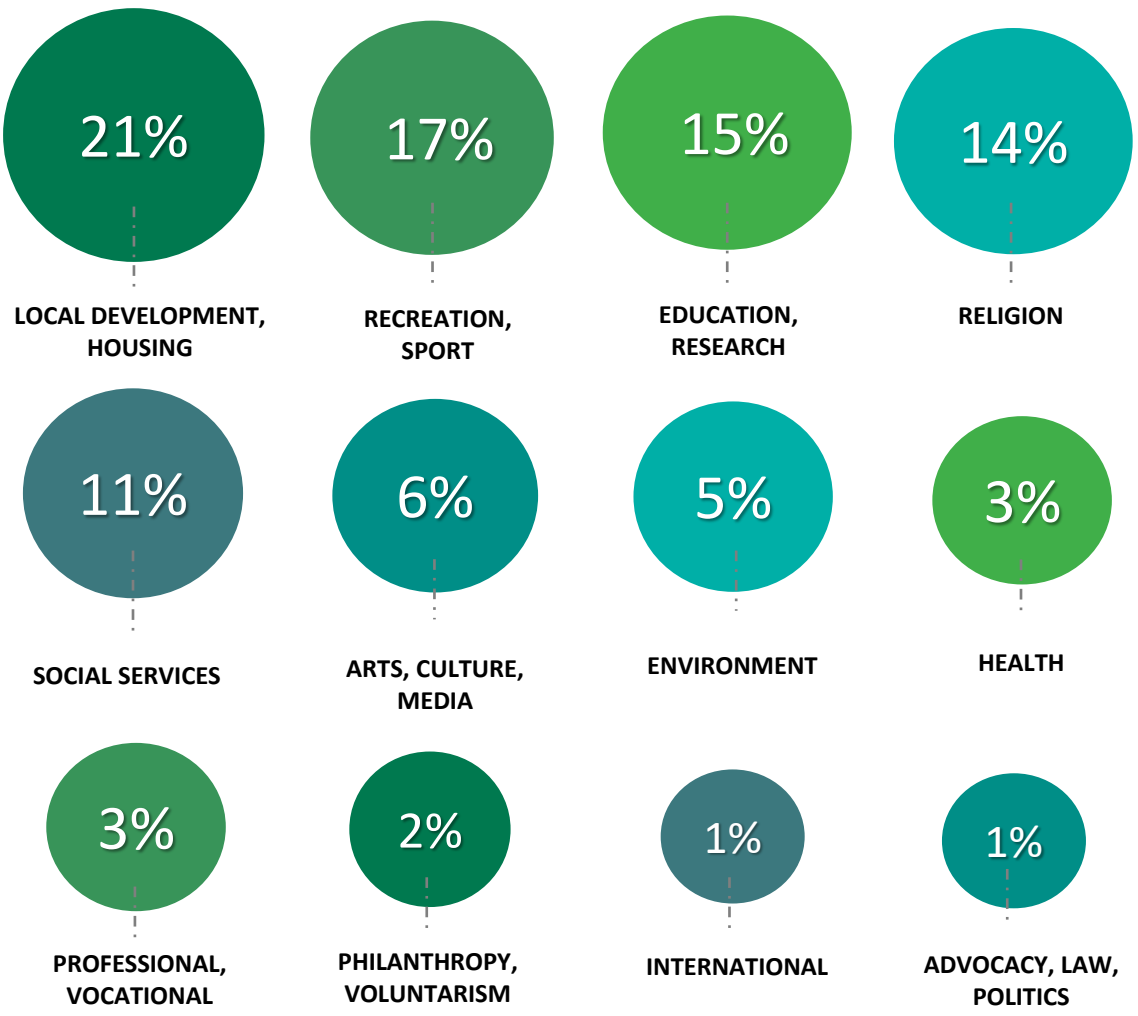

SECTOR OVERVIEW

The Irish nonprofit sector was estimated to include 34,331 organisations in 2020 (Benefacts, 2021), an increase from 2019 when it was thought to be closer to 29,300 organisations. This can be explained, in part, by the growth of the Benefacts database which now includes many pre-existing organisations who previously did not make their data available. It can be assumed, therefore, that the 2021 figure is more reflective of the sector's true size and scale of income.

The organisations are classified under 12 subsectors by Benefacts. While the subsectoral composition of the sector saw a shift in our last report¹, partially due to the addition of more religious organisations whose data had not been previously made available as well as locally registered entities in the Benefacts database. However, this has stabilised and the composition of the entire database in the past year has remained consistent (2019-2020). The overall population size has increased by approximately 1,490 organisations due to several newly registered charities, comprised of mainly schools and new incorporations.

Local Development/Housing remains the largest sector in terms of population size accounting for 21% of Irish nonprofits, with Recreation, Sport accounting for 18% and Education, Research accounting for 15% of the total population. The International, Advocacy Law, Politics and Philanthropy, Voluntarism sectors account for the smallest proportion of the nonprofit sector's population, collectively accounting for less than 5% of all organisations (Figure 1). Figure 1 is a representative breakdown of the total population of organisations as classified by Benefacts and the sample used in this report.

¹ In 2021, the Benefacts database continued to close the gap in data by including existing organisations that had not previously made their accounts publicly available. We believe that the size of the sector in 2021, 34,331 organisations, therefore, provides the best basis for estimates on the sector's size in 2019 and have adjusted our sample and carried out extrapolations accordingly while using 2019 accounts.

METHODOLOGY

The selected sample is based on the annual adjusted size of the sector as per the Benefacts database. Given the adjustments which has been made by sample size and composition, the findings of this report are therefore not directly comparable to previous reports in this series, but rather shows the analysis of the sector in the 2018-2019 timeframe.

This report applies stratified random sampling in the selection of organisations informing the findings. When extrapolated, the relative size of each subsector in the sample reflects that of the population. The total sample size equates to 1,735 organisations, or 5% of the total sector. The sample used in this report, when extrapolated, mirrors the proportional representation of the nonprofit sector. Aggregate figures for subsectors were extrapolated after adjusting for outliers in the top 2% level of each income category.

In comparison to last year's Giving Ireland report (Giving Ireland, 2020), there was a significant increase in the number of observations of reports of income, particularly for fundraised income. This has caused a notable jump in the approximation of total fundraised income for the sector in 2019. This report's sample varies year-on-year due to sectoral heterogeneity and is therefore not comparable to that of previous reports. However, this jump may be partially due to a higher standard of reporting for F/Y End 2019. This is discussed further in the section on Fundraised Income.

For International Comparisons, Modified GNI has been adopted alongside GDP as a measure of Irish income in 2019. Giving as a % of GDP and as a % GNI* has been calculated, showing the effect of including factor income of multinationals' income on giving statistics and the gap between U.K and Ireland in terms of giving.

GNI or Modified Gross National Income is GDP, net of incomes sent or received from abroad, and adjusted for globalization effects which disproportionately influence the approximate size of the Irish economy as measured by GNI such as depreciation on intellectual property, depreciation on aircraft leasing and net factor income of redomiciled PLCs. More information can be found from CSO as listed in References.*

LIMITATIONS

There are several limitations this report faces in approximating the true size of the Irish nonprofit sector. In particular, there remains a significant gap in the availability of high-quality data.

Total income, total fundraised income and the overall sector funding model are projected by applying a multiplier which corresponds to the representation of each subsector as a proportion to the whole in terms of number of organisations *and* the relative availability of data for that subsector. In subsectors such as Religion, Sports & Recreation and Education & Research, the sample of available accounts relative to the total number of organisations in the sector is lower and as a result , these subsectors are slightly underrepresented in the sample.

It is assumed that the profiles of organisations for which data is unavailable resemble a similar profile to those for which data is available. As Giving Ireland projects an approximation of the total pie of income for the sector from a sample of known incomes, it must be assumed that this sample would be similar to a sample of unknown incomes in terms of size and distribution.

Fundraised income, state funding, earned income, investment income trends and subsector funding models are based on and extracted from the data of 1,735 organisations, representing approximately 5% of the total population.

Annual accounts often provide limited information on fundraising. Therefore, a second, smaller sample of 21 organisations is included. These organisations anonymously self-reported their fundraised income and costs by method. Any findings using this sample have been clearly indicated as such.

Income is identified and categorised according to descriptors in organisations' financial accounts. Exceptional items and/or income which is unaccounted for in terms of source in accounts is excluded from the data set. A breakdown of total income accounted for vs. overall total income is included in Appendix C.

TRANSPARENCY

Almost half of available accounts were abridged in 2018

Figure 2 shows the number of organisations with available accounts and percentage of those filing in abridged format. 45% of organisations filed abridged accounts in 2019, down slightly from 46% in 2018 and 48% in 2017 (2into3, 2020)². The total number of available accounts organisations changing reporting periods or accounts submitted deemed illegible.

Recreation & Sports led in abridgement at 66% and had the lowest rate of SORP compliancy- just 9 of the 3,775 organisations with available accounts were SORP compliant. Advocacy, Law & Politics subsector exhibit the most transparency in provision of financial information with two-thirds of organisations with available accounts submitting in unabridged format.

Of the 8,756 available accounts, financial data was only available for 4,646 of these which are incorporated entities, while the remainder of unincorporated entities' financial data is not published by the Charities Regulator³.

According to the 2020 Edelman Trust Barometer, the percentage of Irish people surveyed who said they trust NGOs to do what is right increased by 4% 2019-2020. However, 'transparency around funding' remained one of the most salient issues and greatest areas for improvement, with only 27% of people believing that NGOs are doing well on the issue (2020).

Charities had until the end of 2020 to implement the Charities Governance Code issued by the Charities Regulator, which sets out the minimum requirements for compliance. It is the sector's hope that these guidelines will work with charities in developing good governance practices and strengthen the public's trust on issues surrounding transparency.

² The CRO gave an extension to 11th June 2021 for filing of accounts. It was shortly after this date that preparation of Giving Ireland 2021 began.

³ It is assumed that the population of organisations who submit unabridged accounts and for which we have financial data resemble a similar profile to that of the unknown population for which we do not have financial data.

STAFF

Employment saw a net increase of 7%, while over half of organisations employed 10 staff or less.

FIGURE 3: DISTRIBUTION OF ORGANISATIONS BY STAFF NUMBER Sample size: 1313

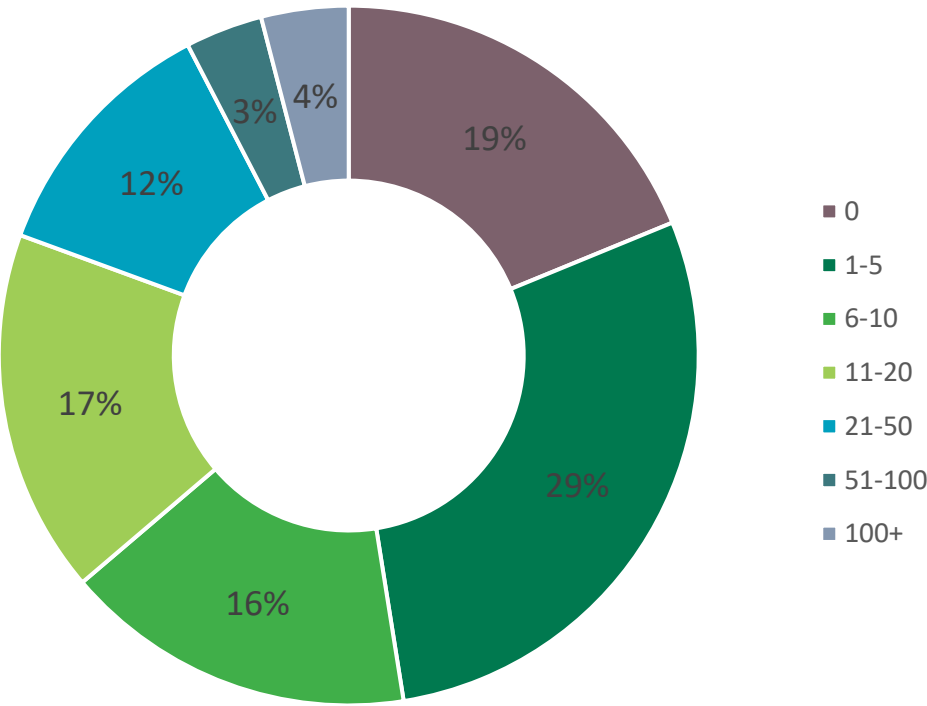


FIGURE 4: CHANGE IN STAFF NUMBERS, 2018-2019 Sample size: 1313



In 2019, 48% of organisations reported fewer than 5 staff, while 7% employed more than 50 people (Figure 3). The average number of staff in the sector was 24, with a median of 6. This gap is reflective of the sector’s heavily skewed distribution in terms of organisational size, characterised by a large majority of smaller organisations relying on volunteers rather than paid employees. A quarter of the total sample of organisations (1,735) did not submit data for staff numbers, which indicates that the number of organisations with no paid employees is likely to be much higher than shown here.

FIGURE 5: TOTAL INCOME BY SUBSECTOR

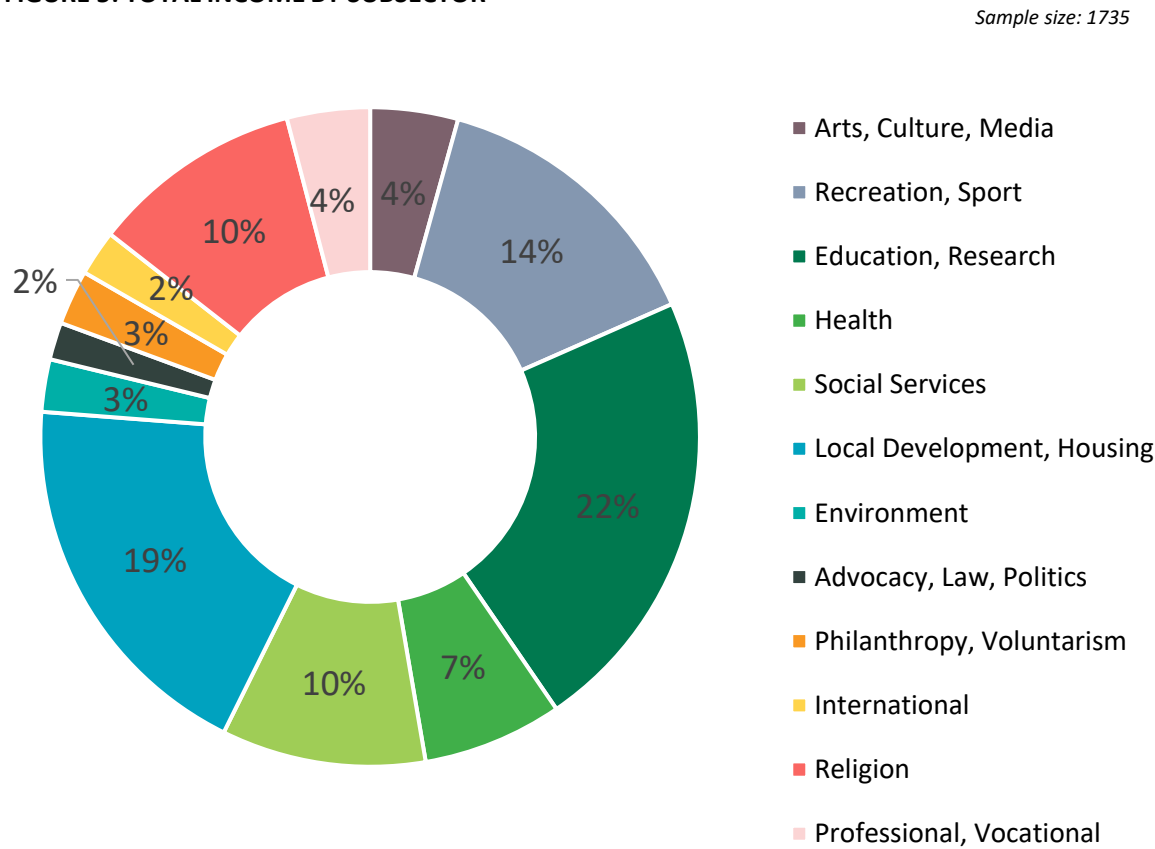
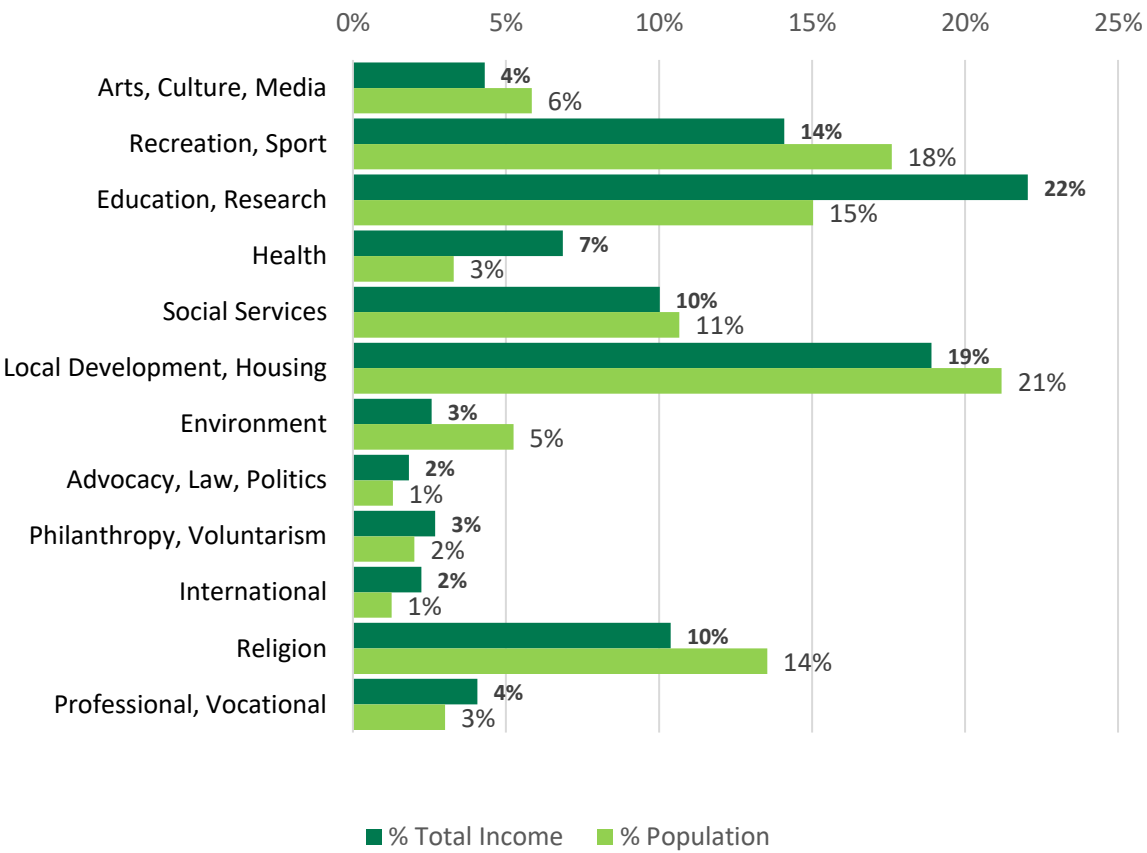


FIGURE 6: SUBSECTOR BY SIZE AND TOTAL INCOME

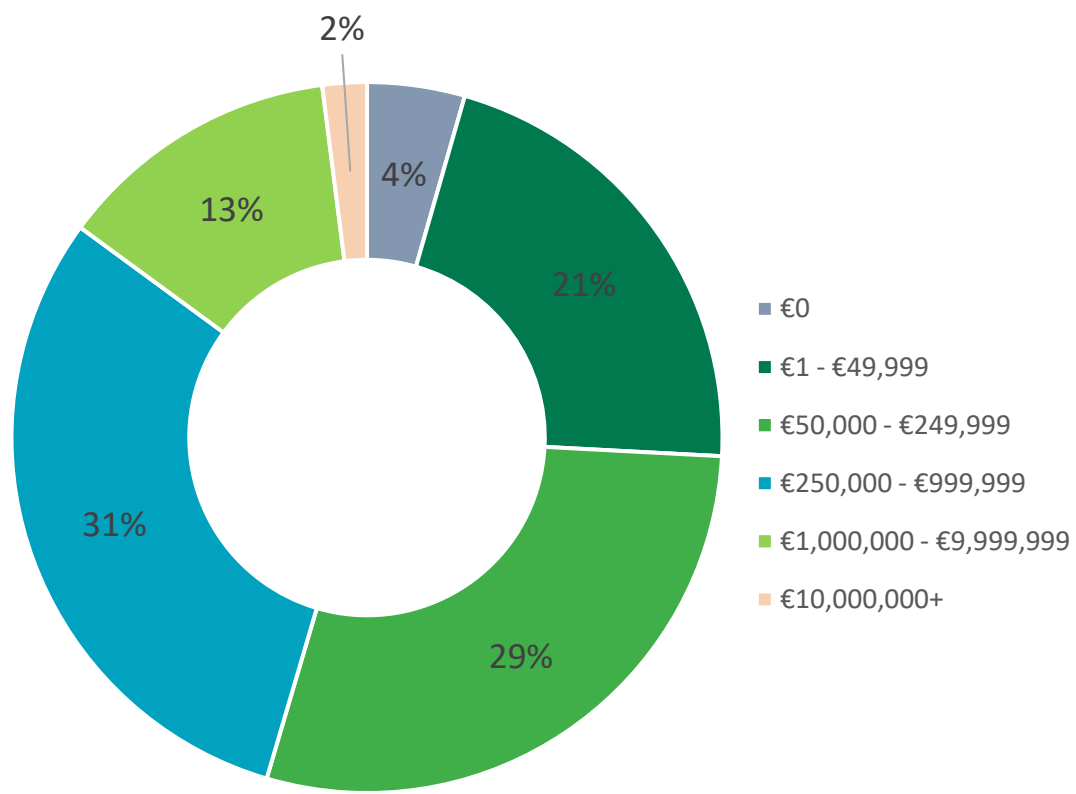


FIGURE 9: CHANGE IN INCOME BY INCOME BRACKET 2019

The Irish nonprofit sector is dominated in terms of income size by a small number of organisations. The average income was €1,177,351, and the median €205,302 (Figure 8), illustrating again the sector’s distribution in terms of organisational size whereby a relatively small number of organisations take in income above €1m (Figure 6).

The pattern of year-on-year changes in total income by income bracket has also remained consistent, although more pronounced for 2018-2019, with organisations in a higher income bracket more likely to have seen an increase in total income for 2019, while organisations receiving less than 50,000 in 2019 noting on average a -6% decrease in fundraised income.

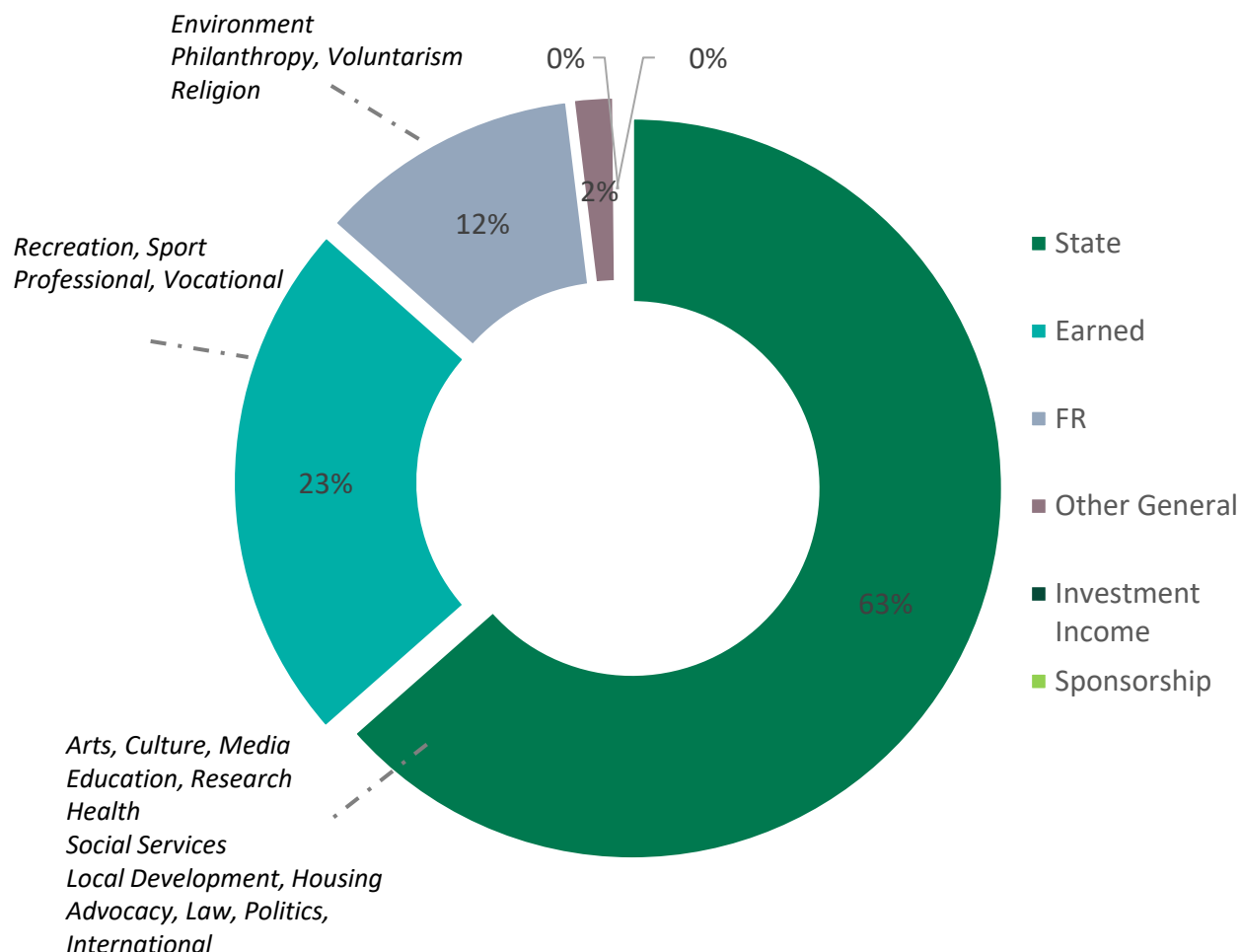
Overall, the sector noted a modest increase of 3% in total income for 2019, with an average monetary increase of €152,261. This result seems to have been driven positively by top 33% of the sector’s organisations (i.e., organisations in the largest and middle income brackets) but dampened by the majority of organisations, bottom 66%, who saw either a decrease or no change in income 2018-2019. FUNDING MODEL

In 2019, State Funding Accounted for 63% of the Nonprofit sector's Funding Model...

State funding accounted for 63% of the sector's total funding in 2019, reflecting Education & Research, Health, Social Services and Local Development & Housing organisations' high reliance on government funding.

Earned Income accounted for 23% of the sector's funding, Fundraised Income made up 12% and 2% of income was recorded as 'Other General' in 2019⁴.

A high proportion of State Funding reflects the significant mutual reliance between the state and voluntary sector in Ireland- the former relying on delivery of services and the latter dependent on funding (Independent Review Group, 2019). The extent to which the state relies on the voluntary sector can have legal and political implications for the operation of nonprofits in receipt of state funding. This is discussed further on Page 14.

The continuation of state support throughout the Covid—19 pandemic has been hugely important in allowing nonprofits to meet the increasing demand of service-users and support the most vulnerable in our communities. The efforts and impact of the voluntary sector in meeting increasing demands and adapting to an extremely different environment should not be underestimated. However, as the country recovers from the crisis, steps must be taken to build long-term resilience. While the societal challenges future generations will face remain to be fully understood, advancing technology and diversifying fundraising sources will be central to building a shock-resistant system. The Irish nonprofit sector's current funding model may inhibit the sector's ability to develop sustainably while keeping apace with shifting donor preferences and the changing demands of service users in a rapidly evolving modern economy.

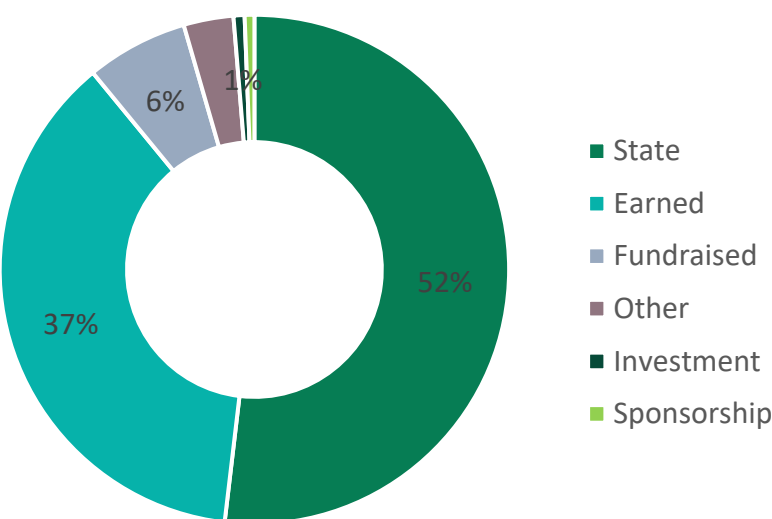

⁴In Giving Ireland 2020, Fundraised Income was approximated at 8% of the Irish nonprofit's funding model, Earned income 38% and State Funding 52%. These changes in proportions are due to both the year-on-year changes seen in each income category as well as improvements made to the methodology and extrapolation of sample figures. This effect also holds for individual subsector models.

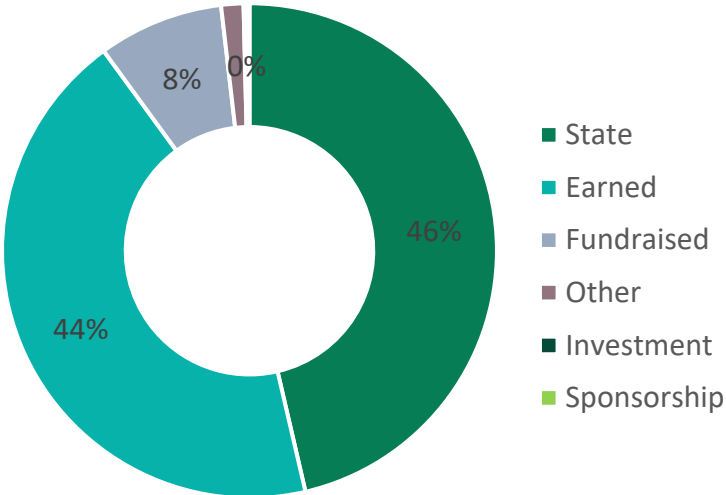

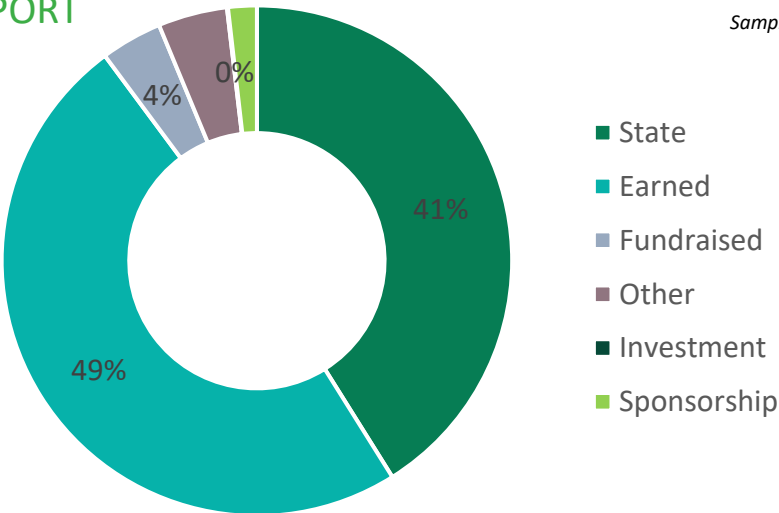

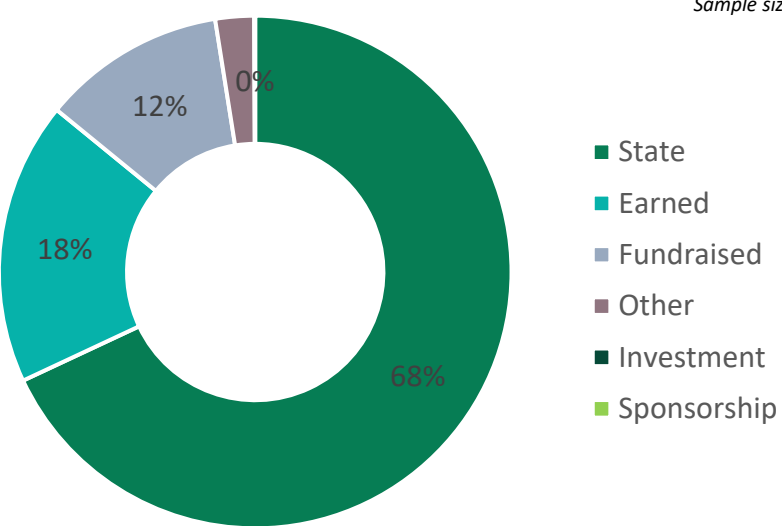

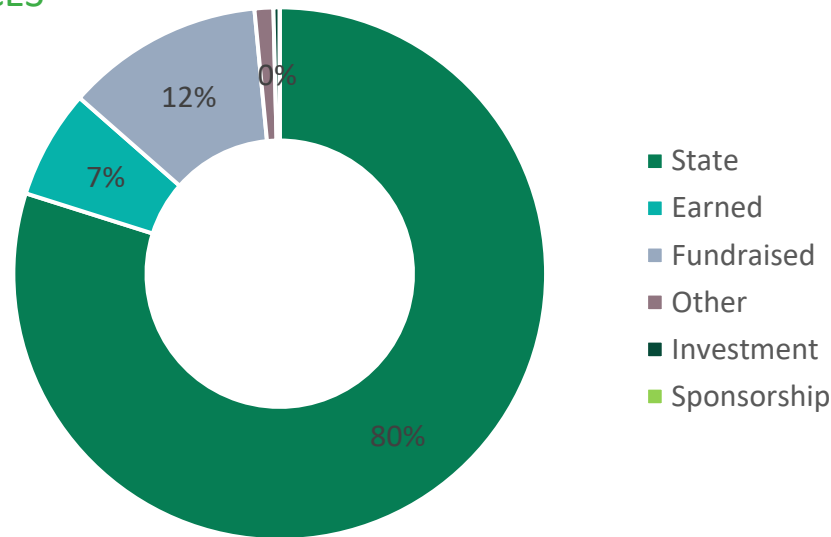

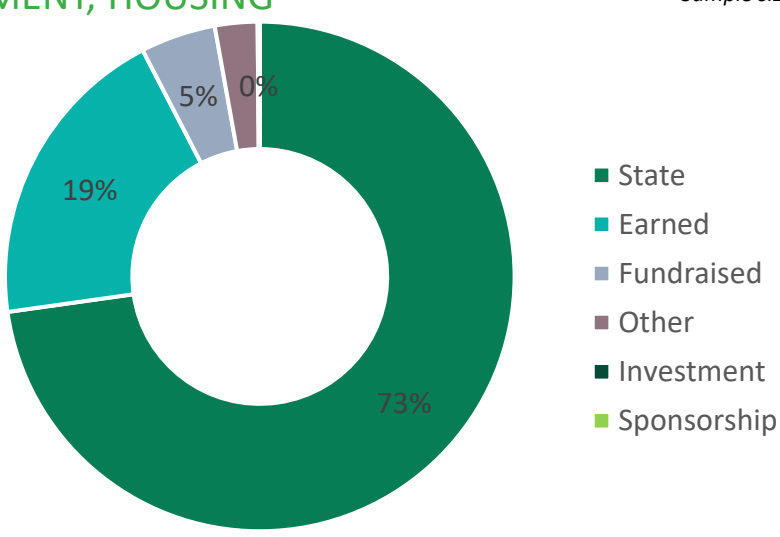

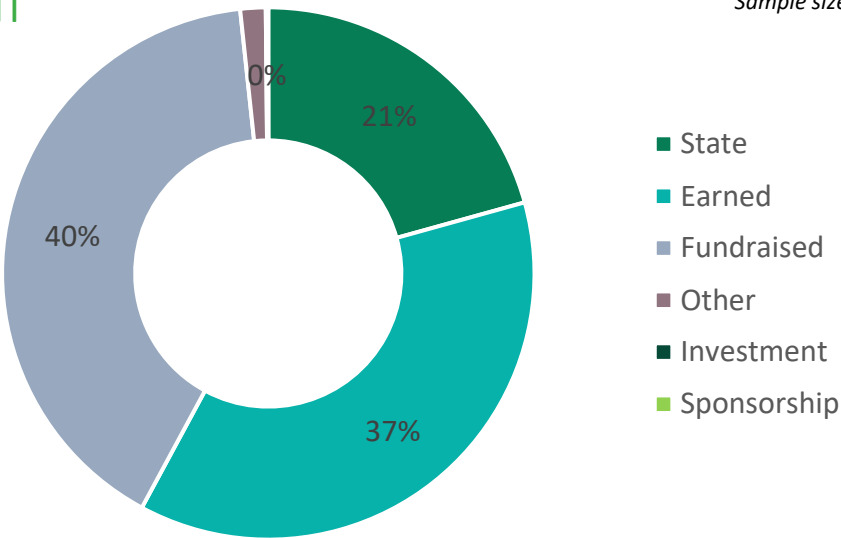

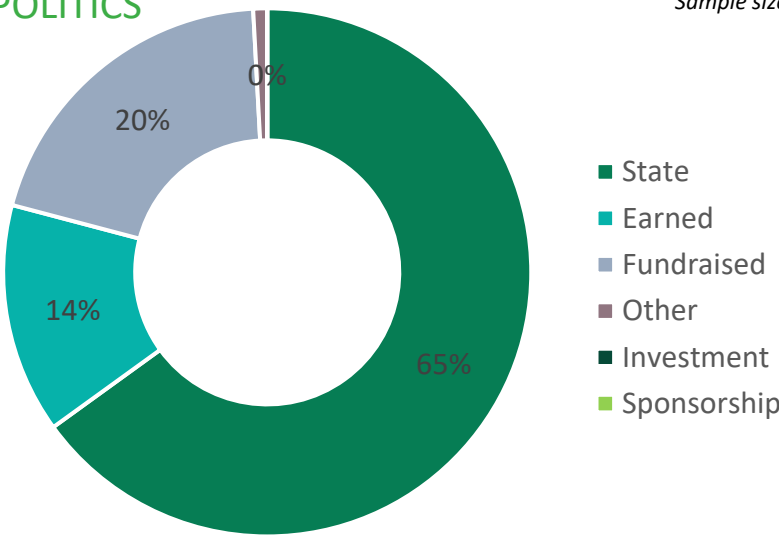

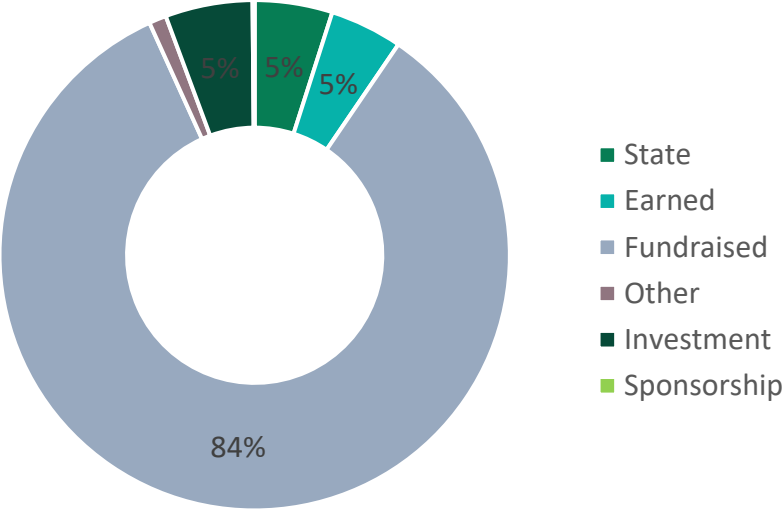

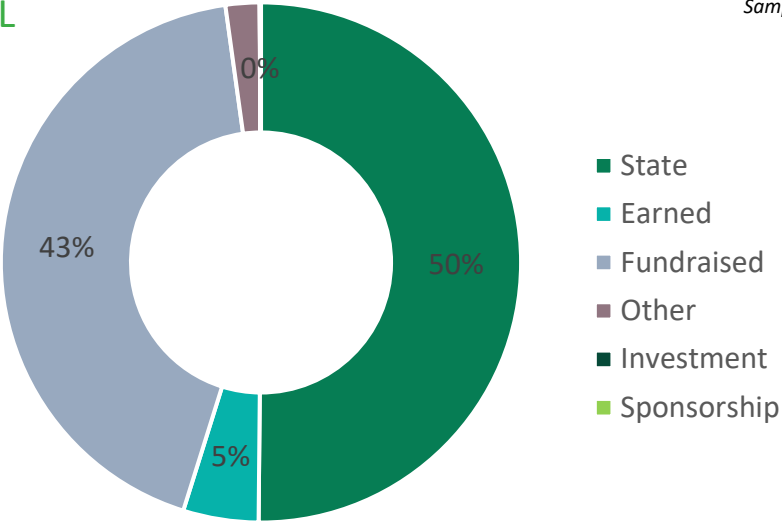

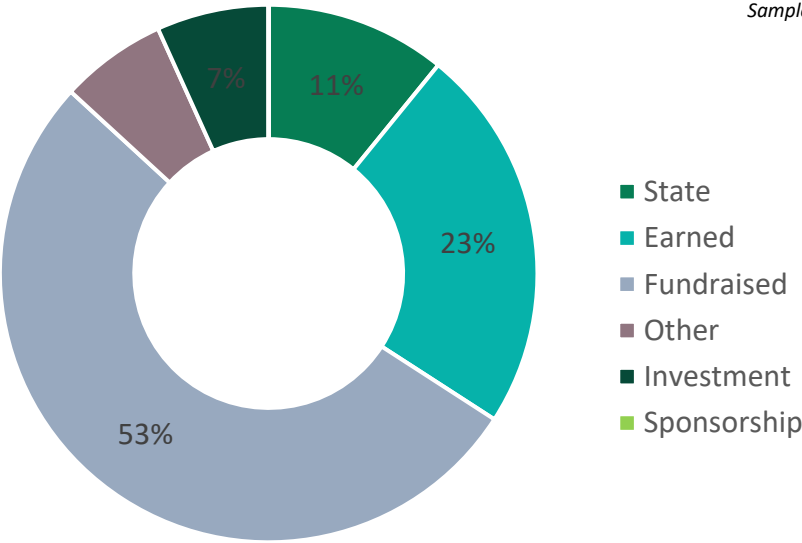

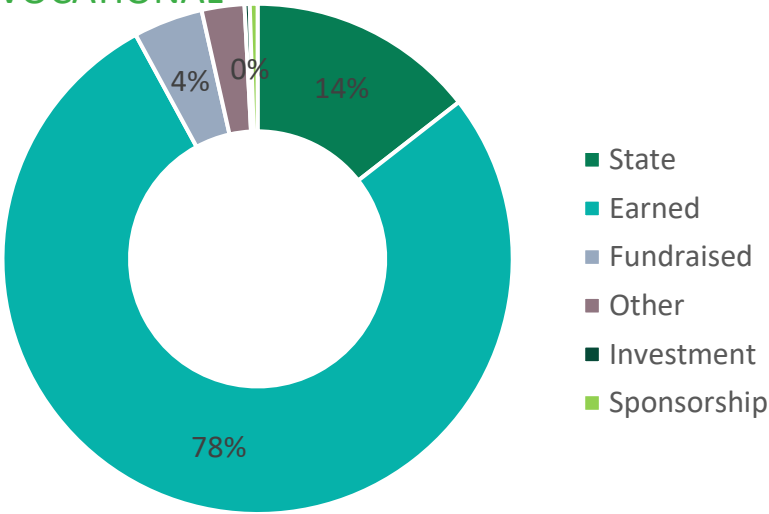

STATE FUNDING

State bodies funded 63% of the sector’s total income and increased 6% from 2018

FIGURE 11: STATE FUNDING AS A PERCENT OF TOTAL INCOME 2019 Sample size: 1735

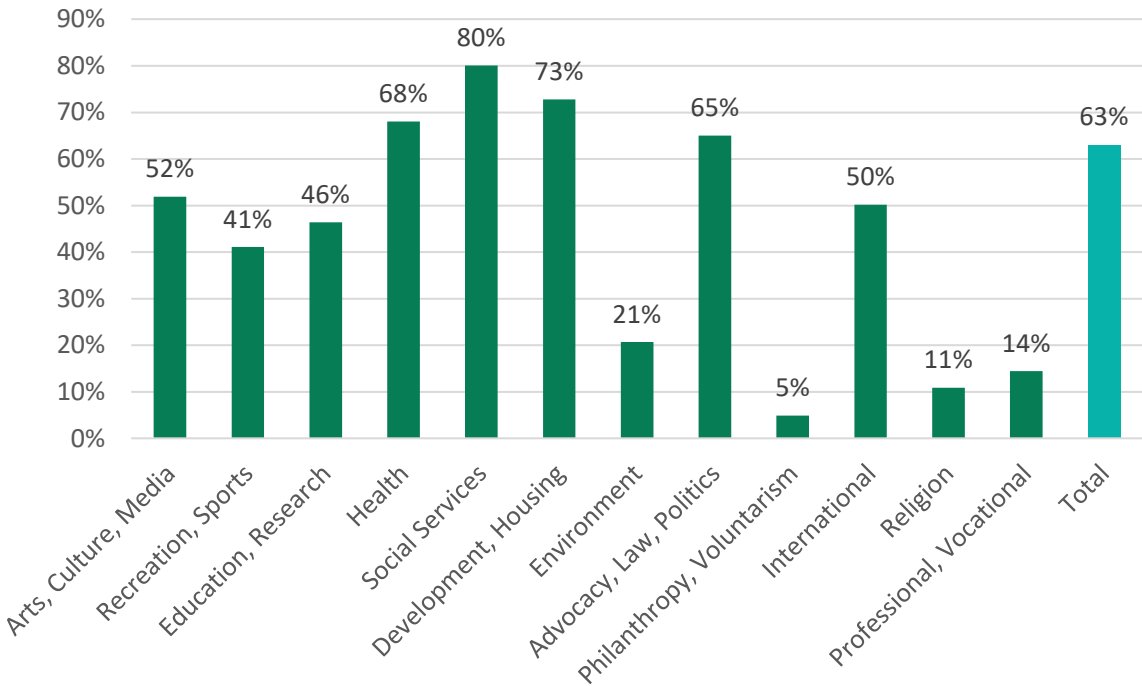


Figure 11. shows state funding as a percent of total income by subsector in 2019. The State continues to rely on the sector to provide vital services to the public. This is particularly so for Social Services, Health and Local Development & Housing, where Service Level Agreements, commissions and rent subsidies dominate their respective funding models.

Such a level of State funding, which Benefacts estimated to be at least €6.2 billion in 2019 (2021), has both contributed to the professionalisation of the sector and posed unique compliance challenges to organisations for whom the State is their primary source of income.

The Irish nonprofit sector’s funding model reflects a significant mutual reliance between state and the voluntary sector (Health, Social Services, Local Development, Housing) to provide vital services to the public. The relationship between statutory and voluntary bodies in the sectors have seen *“mixed success in terms of co-operation at local and national levels. In many instances, strong and effective local relationships ensured the provision of services, sharing of learning, and collaboration on quality improvement measures”* (Independent Review Group, 2019, p. 9)

The repeal of the Eighth Amendment to the Constitution in May of 2018 permitted under law the provision of abortion services. This prompted discussion surrounding the support offered by the state to religious or faith-based health services which refuse the offering of services like abortion, which are now within the ambit of citizen’s constitutional rights. The event highlighted the implications of this relationship between statutory bodies and the voluntary sector in providing essential health services to the public.

The ‘Report of the Independent Review Group established to examine the role of voluntary organisations in publicly funded health and personal social services’ pointed out the politically and legally complex nature of the state’s involvement in the voluntary sector: where the state is *“free not to provide funding to organisations that refuse to provide certain lawful services”* on one hand, but where the decision to not provide funding to these organisations could lead to disruptions and *“consequent detriment to service users and the public ”* (2019, p. 10).

STATE FUNDING

Majority of Organisations Saw an Increase in State Funding 2018-2019.

Figure 12 shows year-on-year changes in State funding by subsector. Several organisations were excluded from this analysis in order to prevent skew. This was due to a lack of reporting for the year 2018.

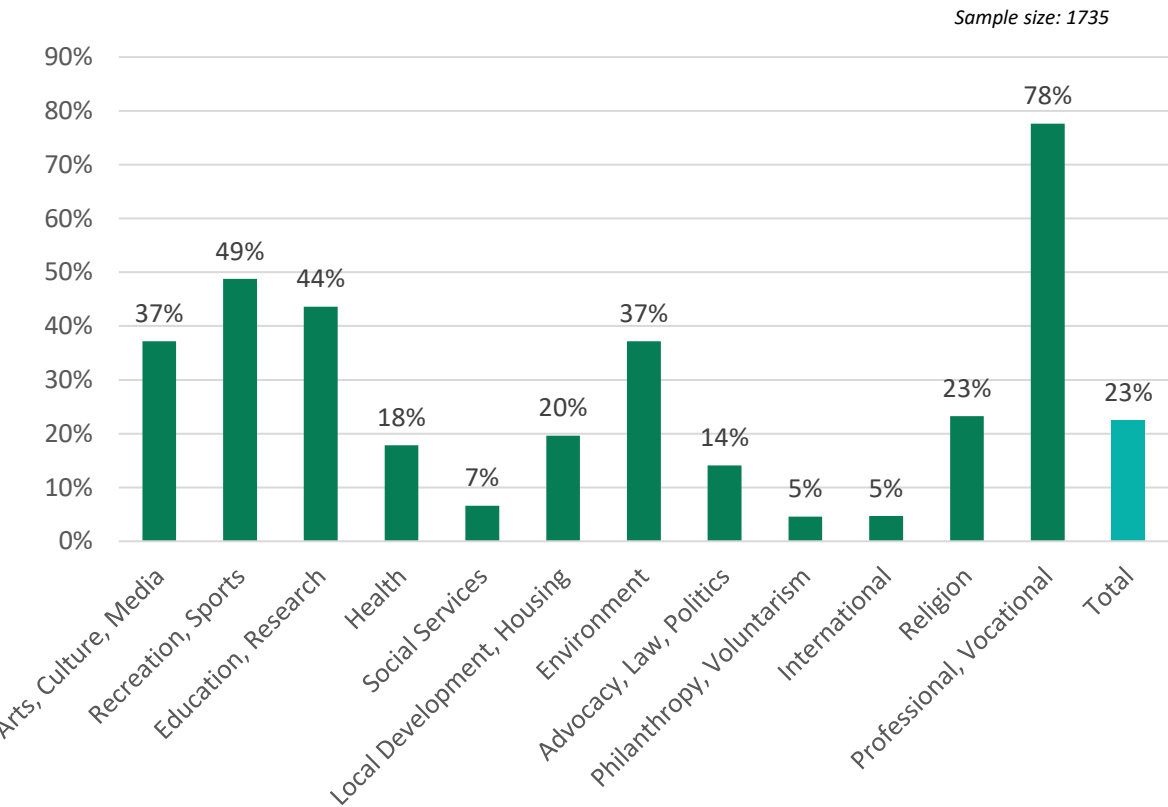
FIGURE 13: CHANGE IN STATE FUNDING BY NUMBER OF ORGANISATIONS, 2018-2019 Sample size: 1530

Overall, state funding of the nonprofit sector increased by 6%. Environment saw the highest increase in state funding at 13%. Health, Recreation & Sport and the Professional, Vocational sector all saw increases in state funding of 7%. Just over half of all organisations for which data was available on state grants in 2018 and 2019 saw a change in state funding, where 65% of these organisations noted an increase in state funding and 35% noted a decrease (Figure 13).

While the Environment sector saw increase in state funding by 13%, it is one of the sector’s least state reliant subsectors, with 21% of its funding coming from state sources in 2019 (Figure 11)-

Community Foundation for Ireland (2020) stated in relation to the Climate Action Fund, that while awareness of issue has grown, proper community engagement has been stunted by lack of funding and the reliance of Environmental initiatives on short-term grants and minimal core funding. The first progress report was published by the Department of the Taoiseach in Q2/Q3 of 2019, showing the relative infancy of state engagement with the issue. As “the climate crisis is without doubt the defining challenge of our generation” (p. 7), it is worthy to note the mobilisation of Irish youth behind the issue in 2019, taking specific measures to propel government partnership with relevant stakeholders and building public awareness. Such examples include Extinction Rebellion, Fridays for Future and the Youth Assembly held in the Dáil in November 2019, which saw 150 young people from around the country deliver 10 climate action recommendations to government (Department of Taoiseach, 2019).

Professional, Vocational sector relied on income from Earned sources for 78% of its total funding model in 2019.

Earned income accounts for almost half of funding in the Recreation, Sports and Education & Research subsectors.

Overall, the nonprofit sector saw an increase of 6% in income from Earned sources in 2019. The only sector to see a decrease in Earned income was Religion (-2%).

It is likely that Earned Income will be the most affected by the pandemic's onset in 2020, data for which will be available in June of 2022. The Wheel report, which conducted a survey of its members 28th July- 24th August found that almost half of organisations anticipated an income loss of up to 75% for 2020, due to disruptions to both service delivery (earned income) and fundraising plans (fundraised income) 71% of the Wheel's members moved services to online delivery, 60% had restructured services and 56% adjusted premises only 4 and a half months after the beginning of the pandemic (The Wheel, 2020). It remains to be seen whether these innovative efforts have reduced the severity of Covid's impact on the sector's earned income sources.

International subsector saw a jump in Earned income by 45%, which was due to the Vita's Green Impact Fund which saw a €1million return on carbon emission sales in 2019*

INVESTMENT INCOME

Only 21% of organisations sampled recorded investment income as a source of income in 2019.

While organisations in Religion and Philanthropy & Voluntarism sectors accounted for 8% and 4% of the total sample who received investment income in 2019, the average investment income was significantly higher than in other subsectors, at €130,164 and €210,059, respectively.

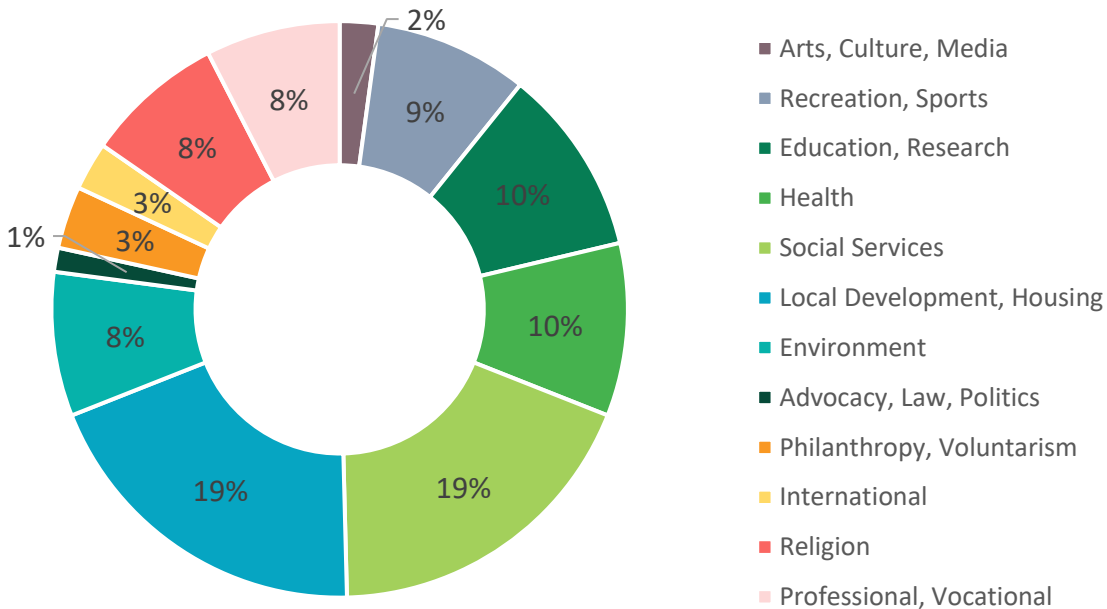
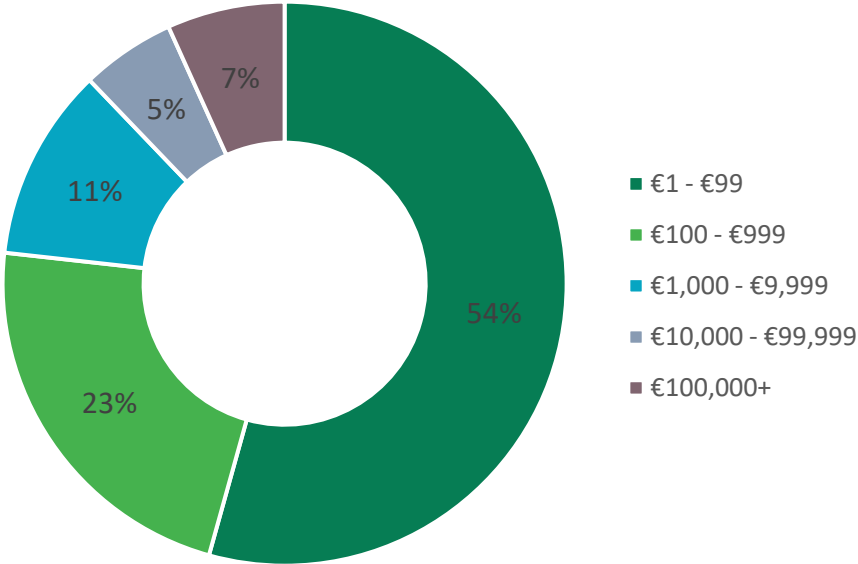


FIGURE 15: DISTRIBUTION OF INVESTMENT INCOME

Figure 15 shows the distribution of investment income by size of investment. Over half of organisations recording returns on investments as a source in income fell in the €1 – €99 range, while just 5% recorded returns of €100,000 or more in 2019.

O’Grady & Roberts (2019) highlight that the sector’s tendency in the past to stick to low-risk ventures also speaks to NPO’s lack of investment in larger, capital investments which would seek to digitally transform the sector.

Such ventures involve higher project and reputational risks. A guarded approach to NPO’s investments may have been integral to regaining public trust following a series of scandals in the sector but a continued conservative approach to investment opportunities could severely limit the sector’s ability to generate capital and transform itself if it is to keep up with the modern economy (O’Grady & Roberts, 2019).

Since both O’Grady & Robert’s paper (2019) and AIB’s ‘Growth and Governance in the Nonprofit Sector’ (2017), which depicted the NPO sector’s investment strategy as low-risk and low-yield, trustees have been forced to move up the risk curve to generate the same return due to negative interest rates (2into3, 2020).

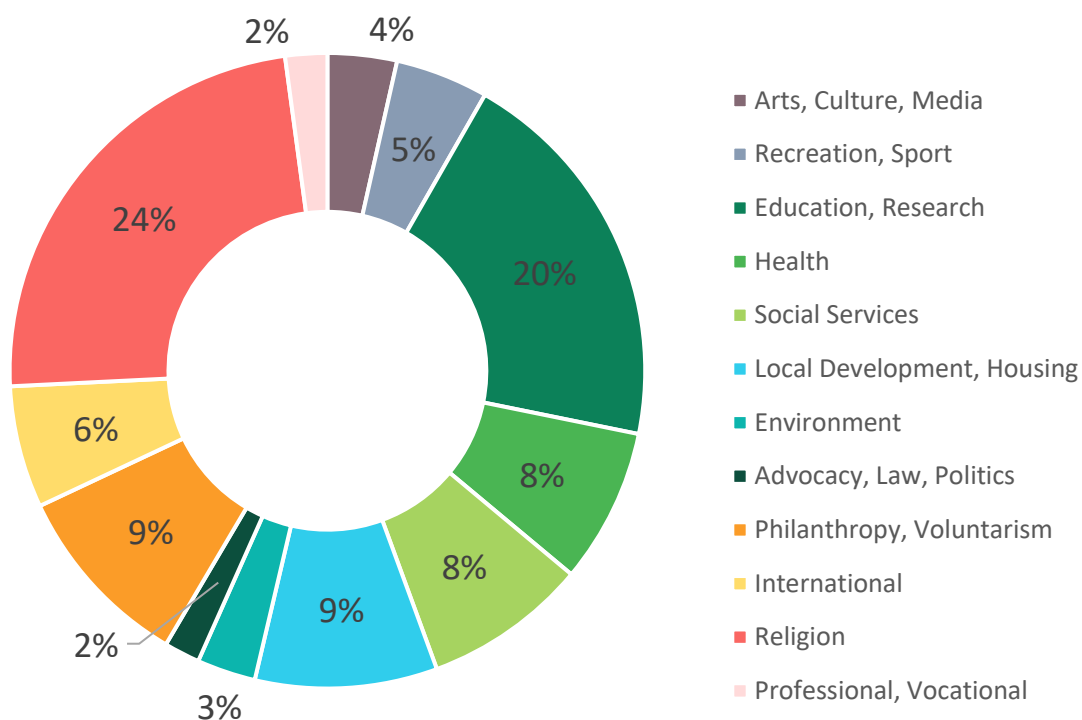

FUNDRAISED INCOME

The total fundraised income for the nonprofit sector in 2019 is estimated at €1.78 billion

Giving Ireland 2019 estimates that the Irish nonprofit sector received at least €1.78 billion in fundraised income in 2019.

Based on Giving Ireland 2021 analysis, the Education, Research sector accounted for 20c of every euro raised in 2019, while Religion accounted for almost a quarter of total fundraised income for the year.

Health and Social Services received 8 cents of every euro raised, just below Philanthropy & Voluntarism and Local Development, Housing sectors which received 9 cents each for every euro raised in 2019. The International Development subsector accounts for 6% of the total fundraised income for the year, contrasting sharply with its position in 2015, when it accounted for 18% of the total reported fundraised income in the sector (2into3, Seventh Annual Fundraising Report).

Religion still dominates a large portion of the pie of fundraised income in Ireland despite the downward trend in donations to religious organisations as a proportion of total donations, noted in a trend analysis using Household Budget Surveys (Benefacts, 2020). Giving Ireland data notes that 'Donations' was the fundraising method which recorded the most fundraised income in 2019 at 27%. This is partially due to the term 'Donations' being used as an umbrella term for several different methods of giving. Even so, Religious organisations accounted for 16% of 'Donations' received during the year (Giving Ireland, 2021). CAF (2020), a report which measures individual giving trends by frequency, reported that nearly one in five Irish donors made donations to religious organisations in the same year-2019.

Education & Research received 20c of every Euro raised in 2019

FUNDRAISED INCOME

Number of Reports of Fundraised Income in Financial Accounts Increased 2018-2019.

Figure 18 shows the total number of observations of reports of fundraising methods for the same sample of organisations in 2019 and 2018.

Many organisations do not report fundraised income by method or report fundraised income as donations.

Donations may encompass major gifts, regular/committed giving, legacies/bequests, online donations. Due to the paucity of data on methods of Fundraised Income, a non-representative sample of 21 organisations has been included in this analysis on Page 21.

1,107 reports of fundraising methods were recorded in 2019, an increase from 1,079 in 2018. This year-on-year increase illustrates the uptake of Legacies/Bequests and Trusts/Foundations which both saw notable increases in the number of gifts reported in 2019. While income generated through the former decreased by -16%, the increase in Legacies/Bequests echoes the overall increase in income generated through this method of fundraising in 2019.

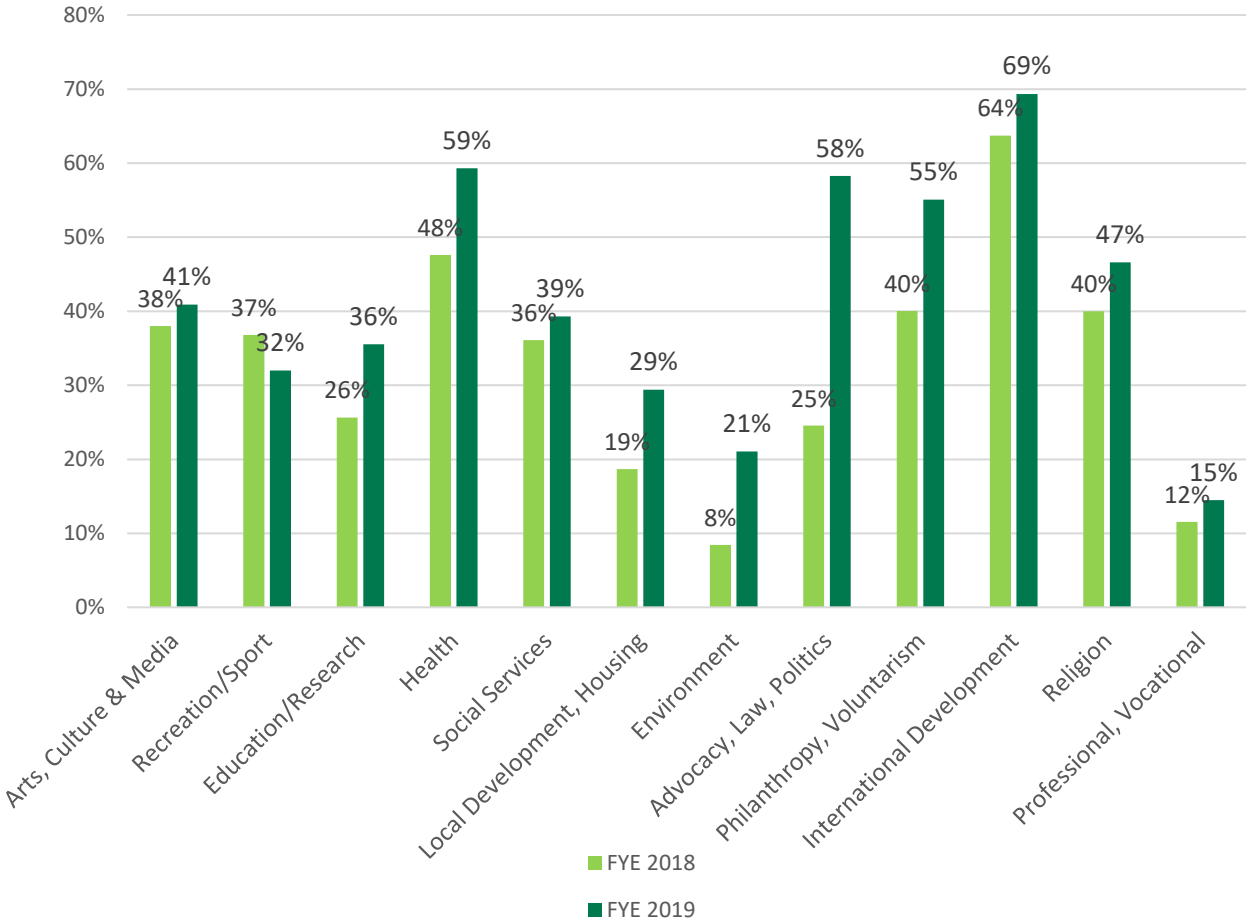

This year, 37% of organisations sampled (n=646) reported fundraised income, compared with 29% (n=484) in the sample of last year’s report. Figure 19 shows the percentage of organisations reporting any form of fundraised income by subsector by FYE December 2018 vs. FYE December 2019. While the two samples are unique and do not contain the same organisations and so therefore cannot be directly compared, the robustness of quality in the data may warrant an explanation beyond mere coincidence.

While many organisations still reported fundraised income in aggregate form (unspecified fundraising), Giving Ireland’s analysis suggests that accuracy and detail in the categorisation of income in financial accounts has significantly improved from when accounts were prepared at FYE 2018 (pre-pandemic) to FYE 2019 (post-pandemic).

Covid-19 has cast a spell of economic uncertainty which poses challenges to financial reporters and boards of nonprofits in making forward-looking assessments of organisations’ financial viability. Such challenges were addressed by the Financial Reporting Consortium in July 2020, who advised preparers of accounts to ensure a high level of disclosure to enable proper assessment of how Covid-19 may have affected the figures presented and companies’ prospects. (2019).

Consideration of these factors, and efforts to give donors/the public and those financially managing these organisations may have induced a more thorough classification of income sources and thus higher number of observations in reports of fundraised income in our sample. The extension made by the CRO for filing of accounts to 11th June 2021 may have also allowed time for organisations to conduct a more thorough income analysis.

FUNDRAISED INCOME

A smaller, non-representative sample of organisations self-reporting fundraised income by method in 2019 was used to gain a more detailed picture of fundraising mix for Irish nonprofits. These organisations cohere to a standard set of definitions for fundraising methods, which gives a more accurate picture of fundraising mix than the sample used for the rest of analysis in this report. The aggregate fundraised income for this sample is just over 102 million, which made up approximately 6% of total fundraised income in 2019 (n=21).

Analysis shows that for 2019 showed that Direct Marketing Appeals/Campaigns and Regular/Committed Giving accounted for half of the total fundraised income for 2019.

Relationship-based methods of giving accounted for 49% of the mix, illustrating the rise of more strategic fundraising methods with lower associated costs and a more sustainable flow of income. These methods have increased as a proportion of the total income, substituting for declining methods such as Selling Something which accounts for a mere 2% of the sample's total income raised in 2019 (Irish Giving Index, unpublished).

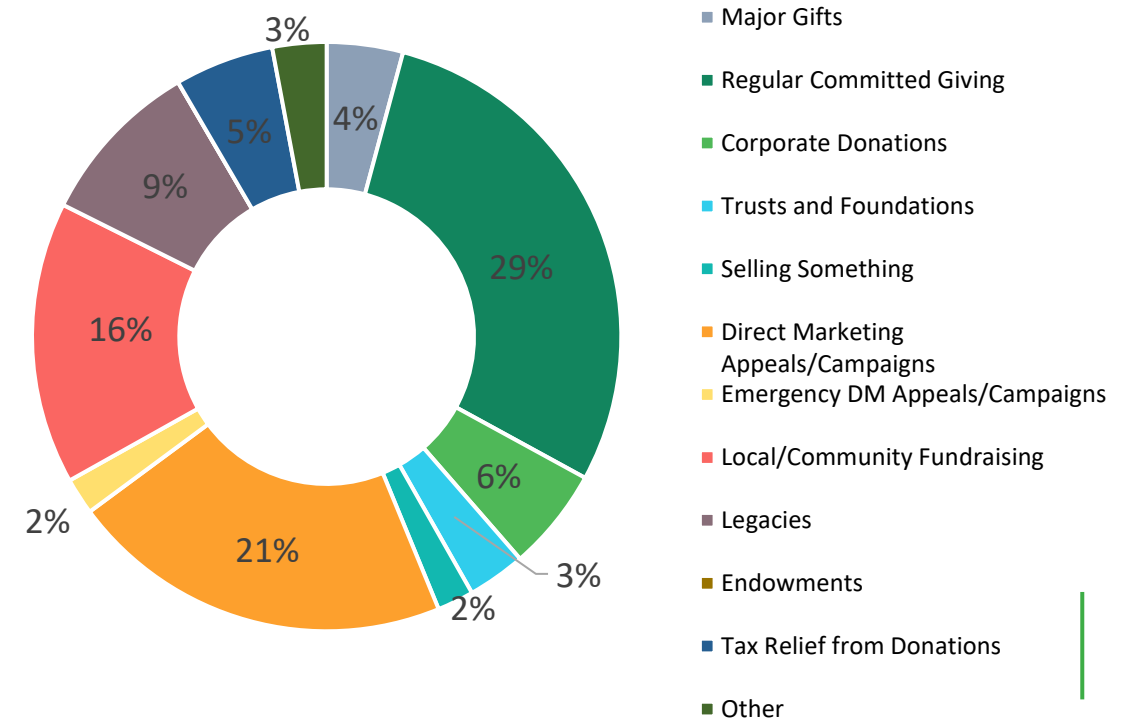
Corporate Donations make up 6% of the mix for 2019. Most of this income is purported to be cash donations, which underestimates the true level of contribution and opportunity for support available in the private sector. Business in the Community reports that 63 businesses donated €19 million in cash, €12.1 million in in-kind donations and over €6.1 million through employee volunteering in 2019 (2020).

Furthermore, philanthropic forms of giving in the corporate sector, such as those of Applegreen Fund and the Vodafone Foundation, reflect the evolving nature of giving and how the private sector can play an active role. This is not only in supporting nonprofits but also in developing the philanthropic infrastructure required for larger-scale giving and the advancement of transformative investment in the sector. However, central to partnership between the corporate and nonprofit sector is thoughtful investment, a point highlighted by O'Grady and Roberts (2019) who noted that organisations included in their survey felt a lack of synergy between the technological ambitions of nonprofits and the investments of the corporate sector.

Since March 2020, nonprofits have adapted and overcome many challenges imposed by the Covid-19 restrictions which have placed pressure on sources of fundraised income. An analysis of the same sample of organisations saw the majority of organisations adapt their fundraising strategies to a virtual landscape and saw an increase in fundraised income 2019-2020. For example, Pieta House substituted its 'Darkness into Light' campaign with the 'Sunrise Appeal', a highly successful campaign which raised €4 million in 2020. An analysis conducted by 2into3 with the same sample of organisations observed that larger organisations and those with more a more diverse fundraising mix demonstrated higher resilience to shocks to fundraised income sources.

FUNDRAISING TRENDS

Overall, the Irish nonprofit sector saw a 5% year-on-year increase in fundraised income in 2019

Sample size: 593

In 2019, giving increased 5%, a modest increase in fundraised income sector but continuing the series of year-on-year growth seen in the past few years (2into3, 2018; 2019; 2020)

Figure 21 illustrates a correlation in the year-on-year trends in fundraised income for 2018-2019. Organisations fundraising less than €250,000 saw a decrease in aggregate fundraised income of -22%, while organisations raising more than €5,000,000 saw an increase of 17%.

Figure 22 shows the overall change in fundraised income for each subsector, and the average monetary change for each subsector. Philanthropy & Voluntarism saw a 33% increase in fundraised income, an average change of €294,264. This is partially attributed to the inclusion of several Foundations/Trusts in the subsector sample which may also be suitably placed in Health- for example, Saint John of God Foundation, Mater Foundation- or in Education, Research- such as the CMR Foundation.

Notable is the increase in fundraised income in Advocacy, Law & Politics due to a 64% increase in income from donations-. The Society for Protection of Children Against Cruelty saw Donations almost double between 2018-2019.

According to CAF's 2020 report on Irish giving trends, while Conservation, Environment & Heritage was one of the least popular causes identified for 2019, younger people were three times more likely than the average person to donate to these causes (CAF, 2020). Generational giving trends may partially explain why we have seen growth in the Environment subsector, which saw a year-on-year growth of 9% in fundraised income.

FUNDRAISING TRENDS

Health, Religion & Philanthropy, Voluntarism Sectors showed strongest fundraising performance proportionally in 2019 from organisations sampled.

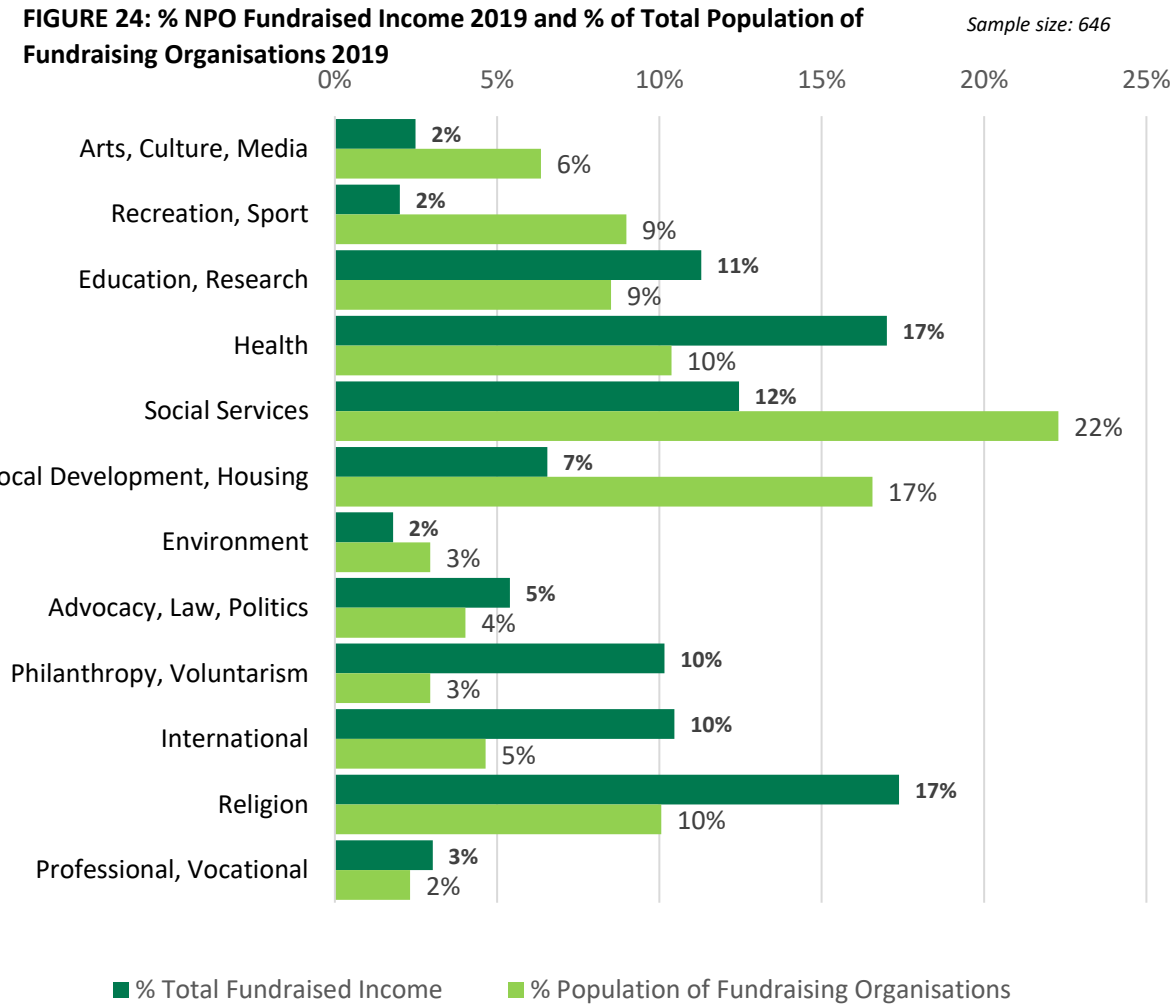
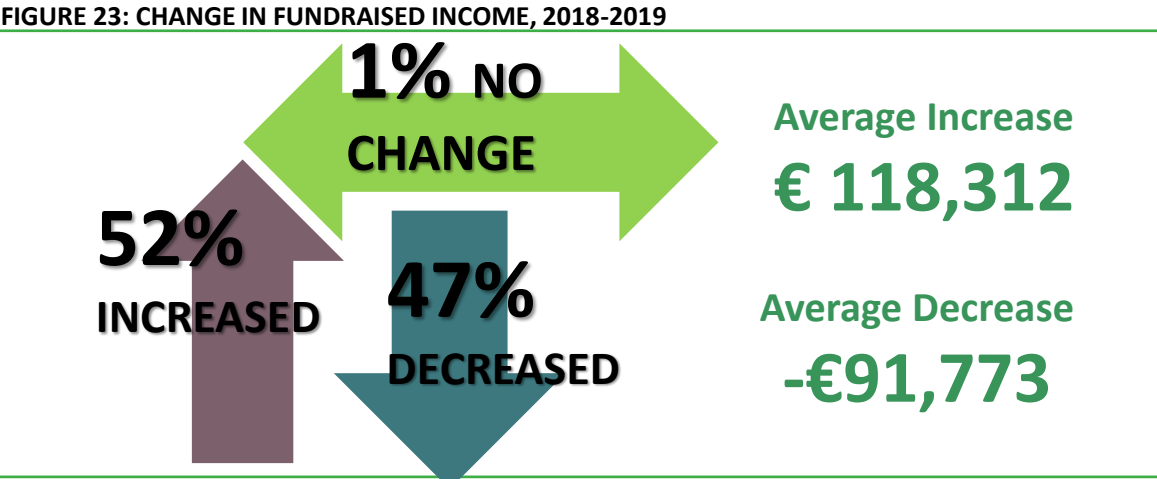


Figure 24 shows % of Fundraised Income and % of Total Population of Fundraising organisations by subsector. Sectors such as Philanthropy & Voluntarism, Health and International Development show evidence of highly effective fundraising, accounting for a disproportionately large percentage of the total sector’s fundraised income relative to the number of organisations participating in fundraising.

While organisations in the Philanthropy, Voluntarism subsector account for only 3% of the total sample of organisations reporting fundraised income, they took in 15% of the total fundraised income for 2019. Health and International Development subsectors also show a similar disproportionately large level of fundraised income relative to their numbers in the fundraising space. (Figure 24.). Conversely, almost all other subsectors fundraised disproportionately less relative the numbers they represent in the fundraising space.

Local Development, Housing stands out, where 17% of all fundraising organisations from sample (646) were in this sector, yet the sector only accounted for 3% of fundraised income in 2019. The sector also saw a significantly lower intake of Legacies/Bequests out of the 8 other subsectors recording this source of income and took in no major gifts.

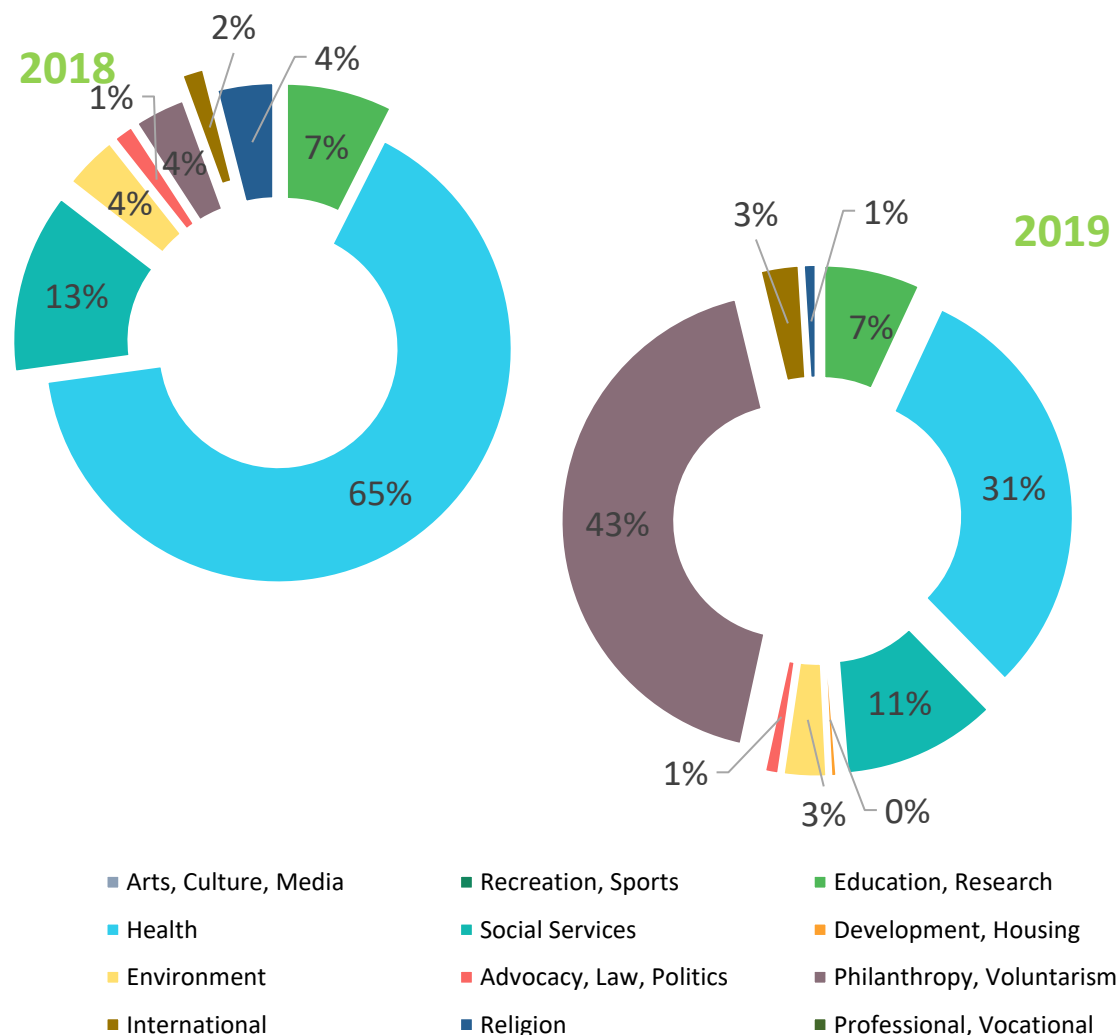

The discussion surrounding philanthropy in Ireland and contextual factors in enabling the culture of large-scale giving is not new (CFI, 2018; Philanthropy Ireland, 2020). However, a notable finding of Giving Ireland for 2018-2019 was the growth in legacies/bequests 2018-2019.

An underdeveloped philanthropic infrastructure and the popularity of small-scale charitable giving is one of the reasons why Irish people have been rated as one of the most charitable nations in the world while Irish giving per capita has historically lagged behind the levels of international peers (Giving Ireland, 2020).

Available estimates suggest that aggregate charitable bequests currently account for about 6% of all charitable giving (O'Leary, 2018), not far from Giving Ireland's estimate that 9% of all recorded fundraised income was related to Legacies/Bequests in 2018. However, this rose to 18% of the share of fundraised income recorded in 2019 (Figure 32). Philanthropy & Voluntarism saw a significant increase in fundraised income as a result. This percentile growth was mainly due to one 14 million legacy left to the CMR Foundation. The distribution of legacies/bequest income by subsector changed considerably as a result (Figure 27). Overall 8/9 subsectors noting income from Legacies/Bequests saw an increase in fundraised income from this method and the total income received from Legacies/Bequests increased by 113%*.

Community Foundation for Ireland estimates that this 6% relates to 0.9% of the inter-generational wealth transfer at death, or approximately 50million. The figure for inter-generational wealth transfer at time of death is projected to increase from 5.5bn-6bn to somewhere between 9.6bn-14bn by 2036 (2018).

This poses a large potential source of income for the nonprofit sector in the coming decades, provided fiscal reforms are introduced to stimulate this kind of giving.

* Excluding CMR Foundation, Legacies/Bequests experienced a 26% increase in terms of income received via this method.

COST OF FUNDRAISING

It cost 28c to raise €1 in 2019

Only a very small proportion of organisations in our sample reported fundraising costs, and an even smaller number of organisations reported fundraising costs by method. However, the number of observations of fundraising costs reported in the aggregate form almost doubled 2018-2019.

In 2019 the average cost to raise €1 was 28c. Selling Something was the costliest method, requiring 82c to raise €1, highlighting the importance of a varied fundraising mix to get the best return on investment. Conversely, Legacies cost just 4c, followed by Trusts & Foundations at 7c to raise €1

Methods such as Trusts & Foundations, Legacies and Major Gifts all have lower associated costs according to this sample of organisations. Such methods also tend to have a higher average gift level (Irish Giving Index, 2019), making them more attractive methods of fundraising in terms of returns on investment. However, this data does not capture non-monetary returns on methods of fundraising, such as raising brand awareness via Selling Something in charity stores.

Data on the costs of 21 organisations was collected during 2020. In Q2 of 2020, the cost of Local/Community Fundraising dropped to just 6c, reflecting the movement of campaigns to online forms of fundraising.

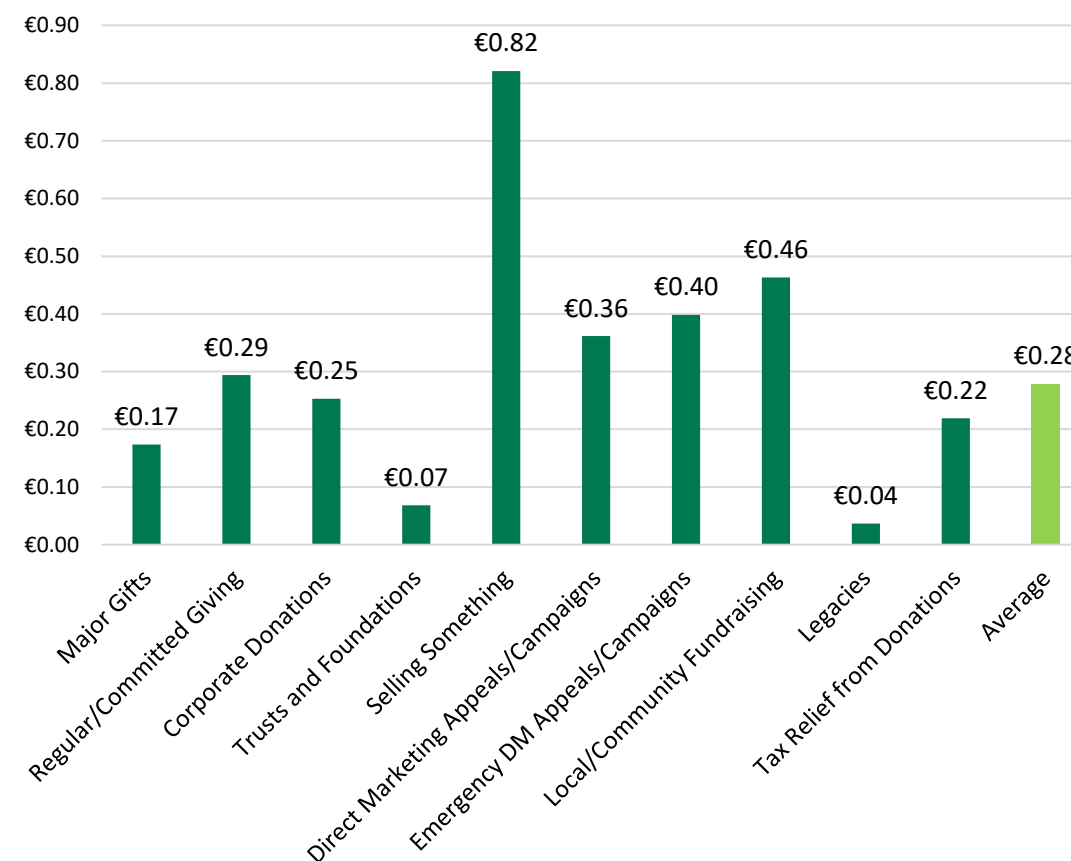

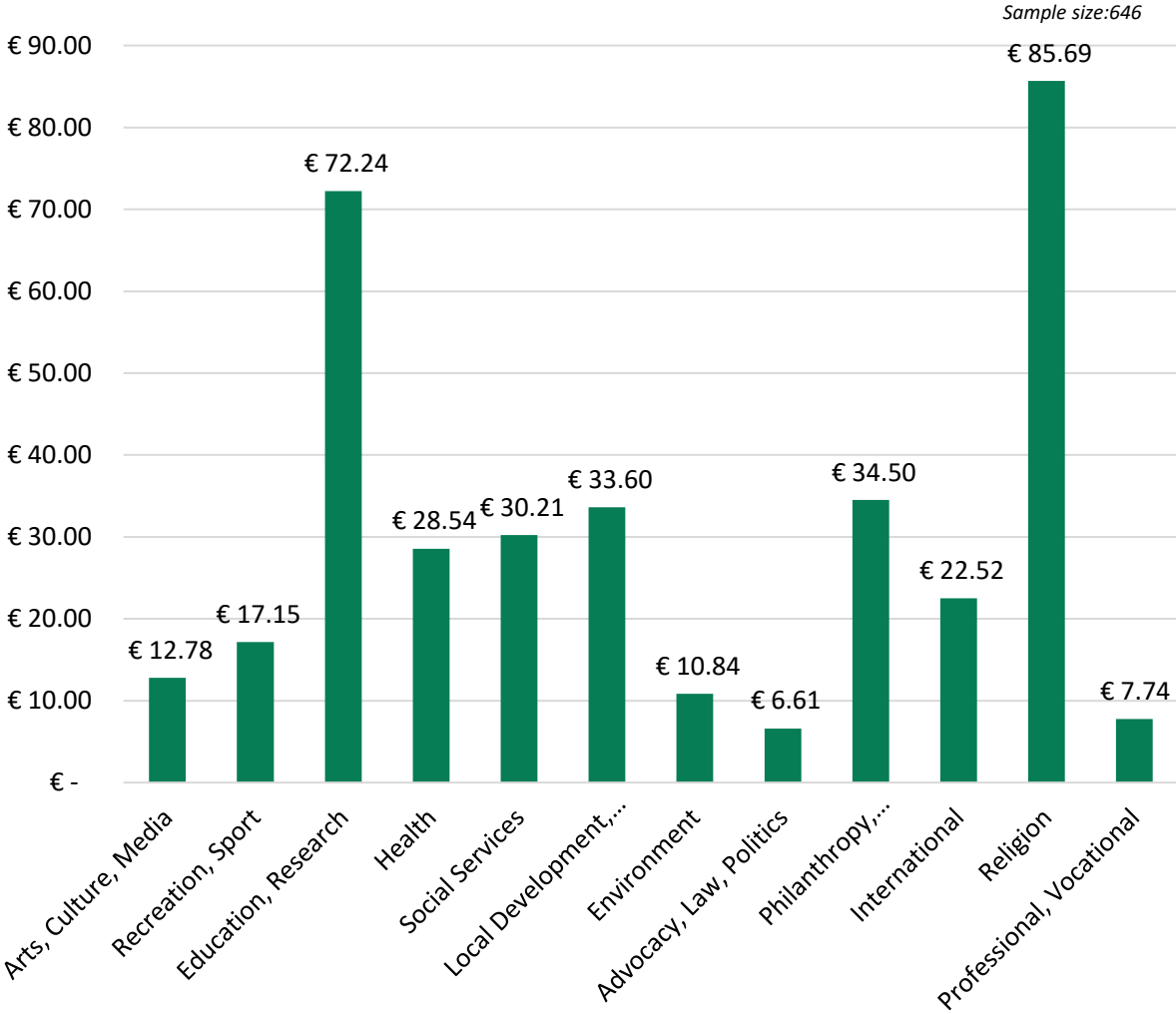

Philanthropy & Voluntarism notably higher due to increase in FR income, specifically Legacies/Bequests.

Per Capita giving and Giving as a % of GDP are best discussed in terms of the pattern seen over time with respect to GDP, fundraised income growth trends and improvement in data quality. While there is lack of directly comparable trend data on giving per capita levels, looking at the growth rates of the Irish economy combined with the improvement in data quality can explain why we have seen notable changes in these metrics and their positioning relative to international comparisons, further discussed on page 28.

The size of the Irish economy has been the main determinant of its relatively low Giving as % of GDP. Due to the Irish economy’s unique position as a hub for foreign direct investment, inflating GDP, Irish giving as a % of income (GDP) does not accurately depict Irish household giving/income*

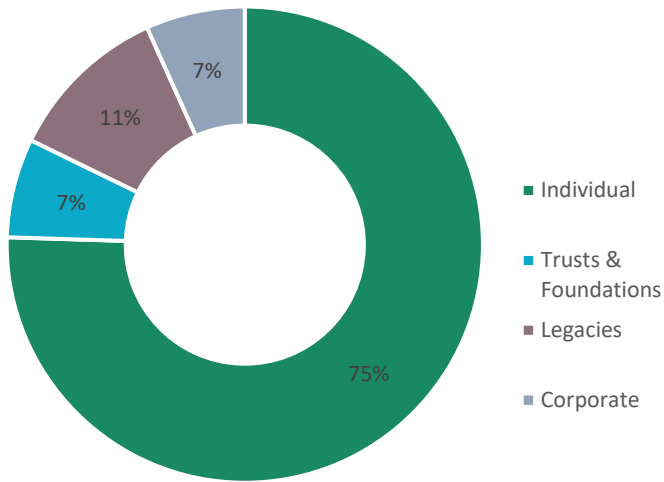


FIGURE 33: UK FUNDRAISED INCOME 2019

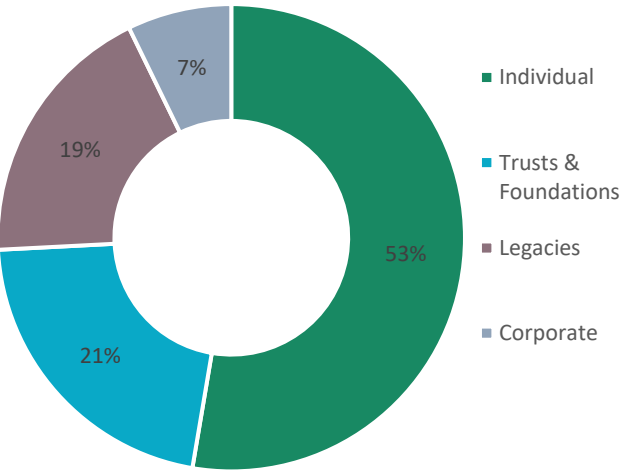


FIGURE 34: USA FUNDRAISED INCOME 2019

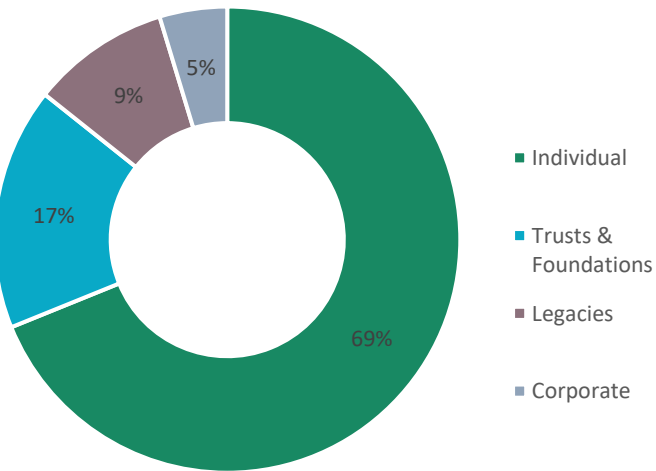
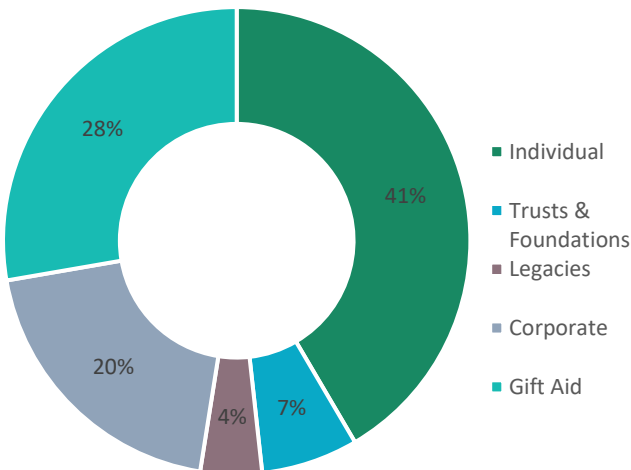


FIGURE 35: NZ FUNDRAISED INCOME 2018*

In 2019, Ireland relied most on Individual Giving at 70%. Trust & Foundations formed 6% of the Fundraising Model, a larger portion of the mix previously thought to have been understated. The number of organisations reporting income from Trusts & Foundations increased by 8% in 2019.

Notable is the proportion of legacies at 18%. Excluding the 14 million legacy to the CMR foundation, this stands at 11% of Ireland’s fundraised income in 2019, and increase from 2018 where it accounted for 9% of the mix.

Caution must be taken when comparing Ireland to other countries in terms of giving, particularly when considering institutional philanthropy. Where Trusts & Foundations in the UK, New Zealand and many European countries include state-operated entities, this report defines philanthropy and therefore charitable Trust & Foundation income as being non-state. No common, legal definitions currently exist surrounding philanthropy or Trusts & Foundations in Ireland or in much of the EU. Clarity is needed regarding what constitutes Trust or Foundation status, or, for that matter, philanthropy.

*Annual data and breakdown of non-government grants for the NZ nonprofit sector were unavailable for 2019. This Funding model reflects the 2018 NZ sector funding model.

INTERNATIONAL COMPARISONS

In 2019, Giving Ireland estimated Giving Per Capita to be €362.

Comparing findings on giving as a % of GDP globally, Ireland (0.5%) still falls behind in comparison to the US (2.1%), UK (0.86%) and New Zealand (0.96%). Looking at patterns in fundraising methods may explain this discrepancy while also noting different social structures across countries.

Though U.S. giving is also driven by individual donations (€276.5b, 69% of total giving), the sector has seen an increasing and consistent growth of trust giving up until 2018, and levelling in 2019, comprising a larger share of the giving than it did 15 years ago (2019: €67.5b, 17% of total giving) (Giving USA, 2020). Proportions are also higher in the UK than Ireland in 2019 (IE: 6%, UK: 21%) (Martin *et al*, 2021), considering there is a substantially larger number of U.K. trusts and foundations (The Cape Partnership, 2021). A Benefacts (2021) report found that countries of a comparable population to Ireland, which has 164 trusts and foundations, have a considerably higher number of such organisations. This may be one factor in why we see a smaller proportion of overall giving in the Irish case relative to GDP as richer philanthropic infrastructure can support giving in these contexts. Nonetheless, the gap between the U.K. and Ireland for overall giving/giving per capita has narrowed considerably, while trusts and foundations in the U.K have faced a series of funding challenges since 2016 in response to market uncertainties

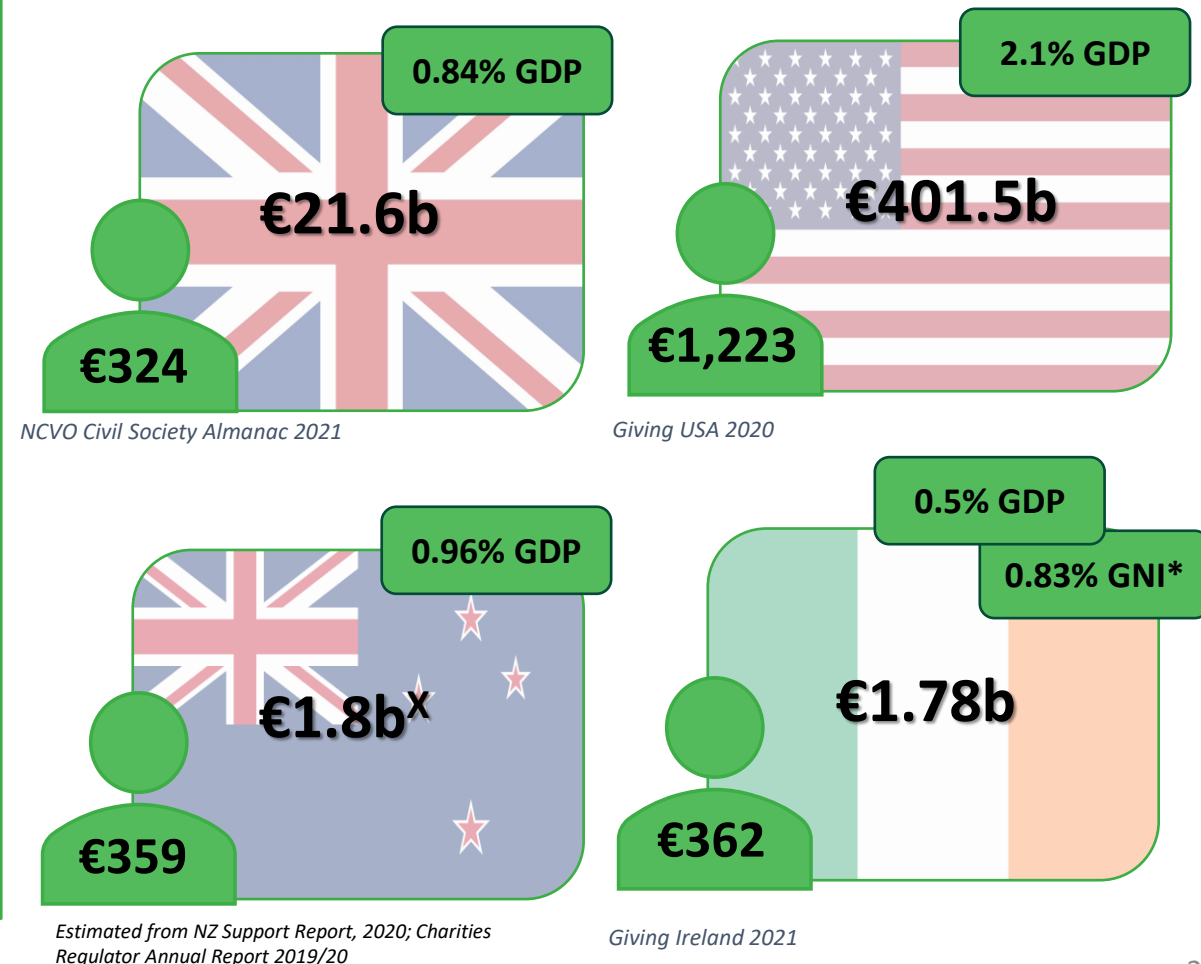
The U.K's nonprofit sector has witnessed a plateauing of government and public income as reported by the UK Civil Society Almanac since 2016/2017 (2019; 2020; 2021). The Irish nonprofit sector which has not faced the same pre-pandemic challenges and has seen steady growth in fundraised income which may be why we see the gap closing in 2018/2019.

The ACF 2020 Foundation Giving Trends update report notes that in the UK, “pre-pandemic, foundations were already beginning to face major funding challenges” (p. 5). The report, which tracks the 90% of the value of giving by philanthropically-funded foundations, both serves as an indicator of philanthropic funds coming into the UK NP sector and money being spent via grants on other NPOs.

The UK's top 300 foundations witnessed a sharp fall in the value of investments, a fact likely explained by the uncertainties in global markets in 2018-2019 with BREXIT, China-US trade disputes and the slowdown effect of China's attempts to deleverage and reduce its debt. The report notes that a smaller proportion of Foundations (41%) increased their funding from previous years' levels, a key source of income for the U.K's nonprofit sector (21%).

FIGURE 30: INTERNATIONAL INCOME PER CAPITA, GIVING PER CAPITA AND AS PERCENT OF GDP, 2019

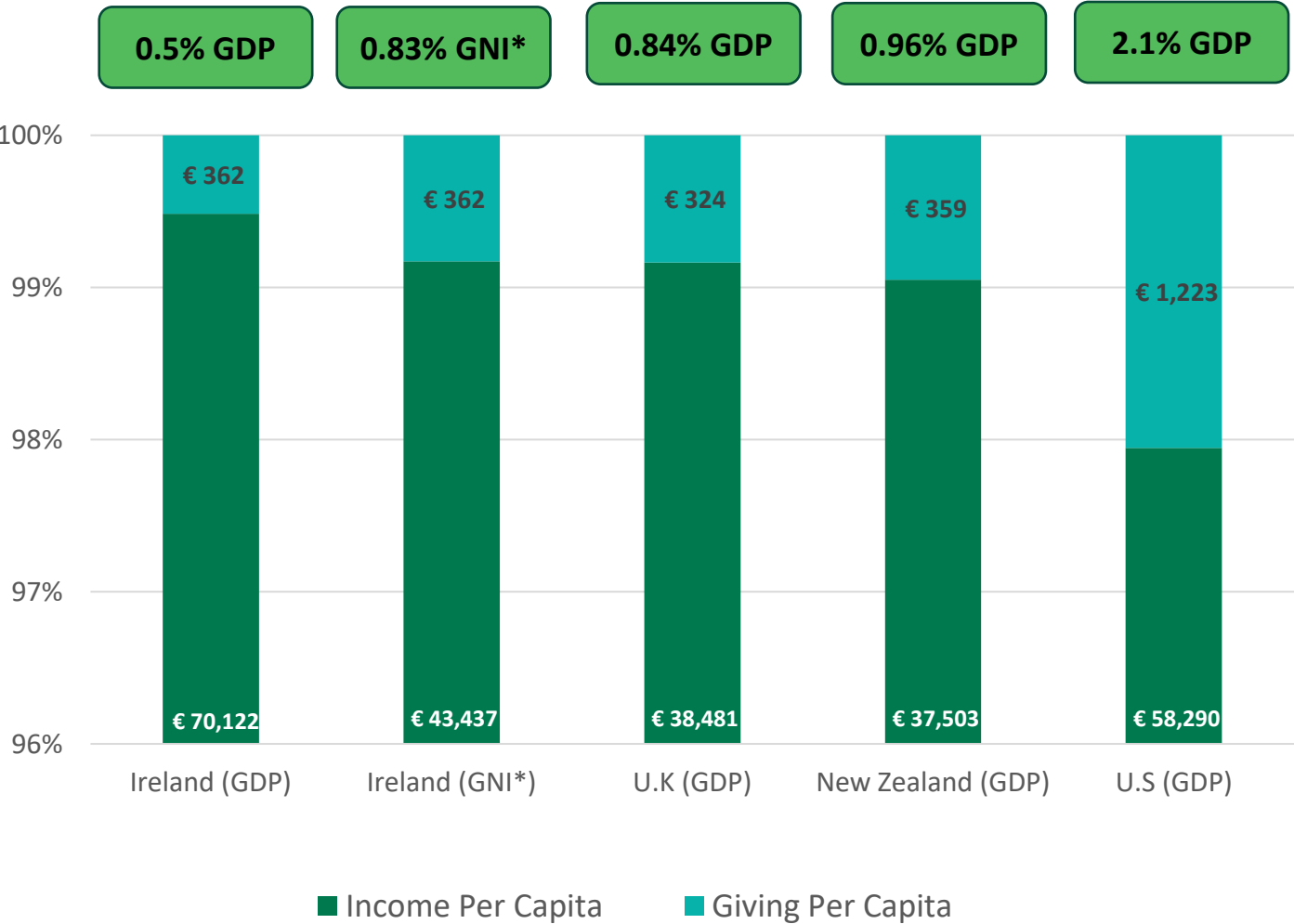

Irish tax incentives for multinational corporations are well known, however, the effect of profits coming from BEPS tools^x on economic statistics have been obscured until recently. In February 2017, Economic Statistics Review Group recommended the use of Modified GNI (Gross National Income), as a better measure of the true position of the Irish economy. Defined by the CSO as “Irish GNI less the effects of the profits of re-domiciled companies and the depreciation of intellectual property products and aircraft leasing companies”. In 2019, the inclusion of globalisation effects inflated GDP by 40% (Appendix D).

When using GDP as the measure for national income, Ireland’s Income Per Capita is almost double that of U.K’s (38,481) and New Zealand’s (37,503) at 70,122. Following from this, Giving as a % of Income for Ireland lies 0.3%-1.6% below its international peers when Irish income is measured using GDP. Using Modified GNI sees Ireland’s Giving as a % of Income come in at 0.83%, only 0.01% below the U.K.

Modified GNI may represent a more accurate picture of average Irish household income, and can partially explain why previous estimates of Irish giving falls behind other countries, or why Ireland is touted as one of the most generous nations in terms of charitable giving but lags behind when it comes to larger-scale/philanthropic giving.

A consideration for the Irish nonprofit sector, is whether this extra 27,000 per capita in Irish GDP is exploitable from a fundraiser’s perspective. The Irish economy’s unique position as a hub for foreign direct investment may represent an opportunity for the nonprofit sector in activating strategic and transformational giving.

^xBEPS tools refer to Base Erosion and Profit-Shifting “tax-motivated income shifting” adopted by MNCs (Dharmapala, 2014). Ireland is a hub for BEPS activity, which disproportionately inflates national economic statistics such as GDP (Alstadsæter et. al, 2018).

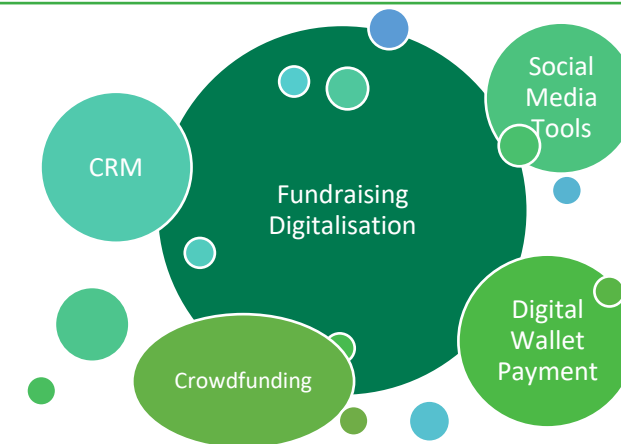
Opportunities and Challenges: A tool to improve fundraising effectiveness, service delivery and transparency?

Today, technology has proved to be more important than ever. The Irish nonprofit sector's funding model poses challenges to this effect, with the high level of state funding potentially limiting scope for capital investment into long-term technological projects. Additionally, while the development of a philanthropic marketplace may provide another source of large-scale gifts necessary for such projects, the lack of suitable tax incentives to allow such methods (legacies, major gifts, endowments) to flourish continues to limit possibilities. Furthermore, ensuring that private sector investment and partnership on technological advancement in the nonprofit sector is effective will require an in-depth look at how nonprofits' technological ambitions and corporate entities' goals line up. The gap between Giving as a % of GDP vs. GNI* indicates a large pot of untapped resources in the Irish economy and opportunity for large-scale gifts to support capital investments.

A 2019 survey on Global Technology use reported that while 60% of Irish nonprofits report using CRM software, well above the EU average (43%), this is lower than North American uptake (US and Canada: 64%); of those, 21% of Irish organisations are unhappy with their CRM, with the most cited problem being an outdated system (Digital Charity Lab, 2019) (Nonprofit Tech for Good, 2019). Tracking of ROI on social media remains low at 28%, though this is in line with other regions (Digital Charity Lab, 2019). Only 30% of Irish charities are using Facebook's Fundraising tools, well below the combined US and Canadian figure of 45% (Ibid). On a global scale, Irish NPOs perform close to the global average for accepting donations on websites (62% vs 64%) and outperform on recurring giving (92% vs 68%), but there has been less of a take-up of new methodologies such as digital wallet payments (1% vs 10%) and tools such as crowdfunding (18% vs 31%) (Nonprofit Tech for Good, 2019). The natural experiment precipitated by COVID-19 for digitalisation may highlight how the sector fared in shifting to primarily digital strategies and reveal areas in which strategic targeting initiatives will be most effective.

Trends in subsector growth point to changing donor priorities. While Health and Religious organisations led overall in Irish fundraising, substantial growth was seen in Philanthropy (33.2%), Advocacy (28.2%) and Environment (9.2%). In the U.S., environmental organisations saw their sixth consecutive year of growth, at 9.4% (inflation-adjusted) in 2019 (€13b) (Giving USA, 2020). Research in public attitude trends between 2010-2017 in the U.S. have noted millennials are cause oriented (Feldman, Thayer, & Wall, 2019). According to U.S. donor-advised fund programme Fidelity Charitable's internal data, advocacy-based, health and environmental NPOs leading among this cohort in 2019 (2020). CAF's report on Irish giving trends echoes this finding, with Irish people between the ages of 18-24 three times more likely to donate to causes related to Environment, Heritage (2020).

Prioritising loyalty to issues over institutions means that support is based on the perceived effectiveness of their donation (Feldman, Thayer, & Wall, 2019). More and more, donors are seeking information on the organisations' impact, aims, communities served, and costs before deciding to give (Root Cause, 2019). Investment in technology is often touted as a solution to not only fundraising limitations but also increasing transparency through providing accessible information and tracking organisations' performance.



CONCLUSION

2019 was a year of continued growth for the Irish nonprofit sector.

While the true extent of the pandemic's impact on the Irish nonprofit sector will only be uncovered with the availability of data for 2020, the findings of this report reflect the Irish nonprofit sector's strong foundations and opportunities for growth.

The tremendous efforts and success of Irish nonprofits and staff in providing services to the most vulnerable in our communities has illuminated a strong sense of justice and shared duty of care that permeates Irish society. It is this characteristic which will be the driving force of future growth in the Irish nonprofit sector

Continued investment in digitalisation, diversification of fundraising methods, cultivation of philanthropic giving through corporate engagement and higher transparency are all key determinants in technologically transforming the sector, and communicating information which donors are increasingly seeking to make decisions on where to place philanthropic support.

2019, the year before the pandemic, is a significant viewpoint for identifying the strengths and weaknesses in the sector and opportunities and challenges in forging a path forward. Giving Ireland believes that taking stock of a pre-pandemic picture of the Irish nonprofit sector in 2019 is central to building resilience into the sector's future model.

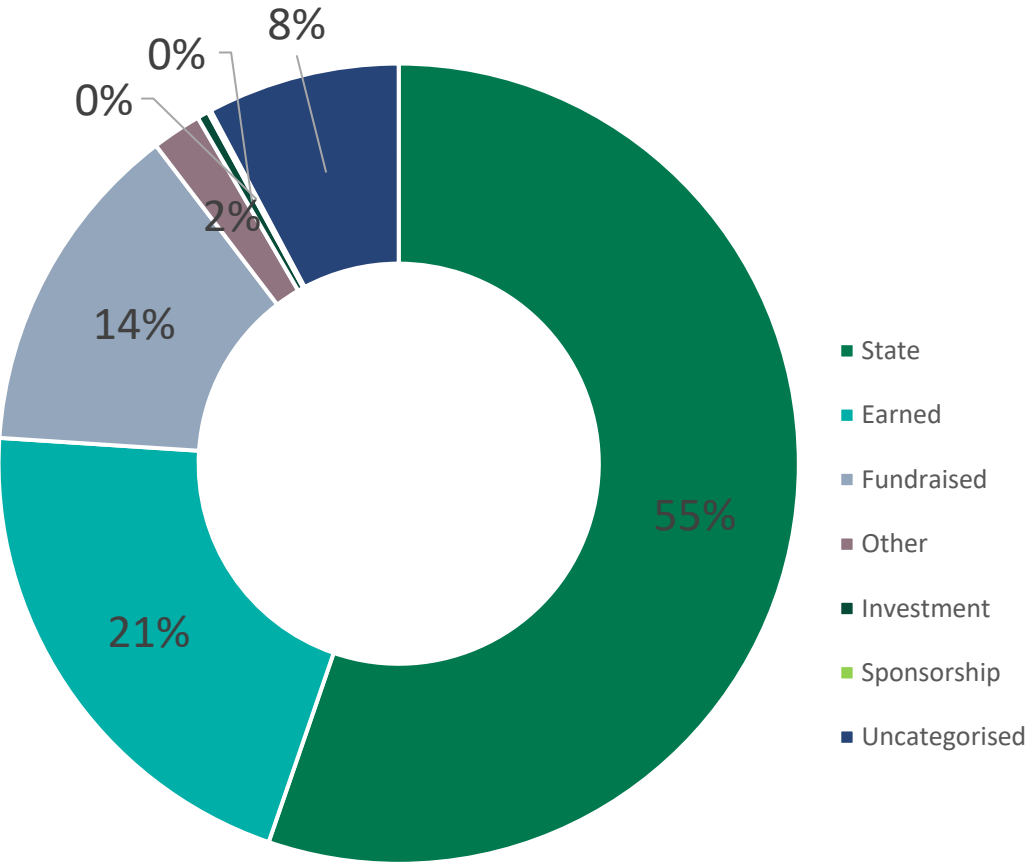

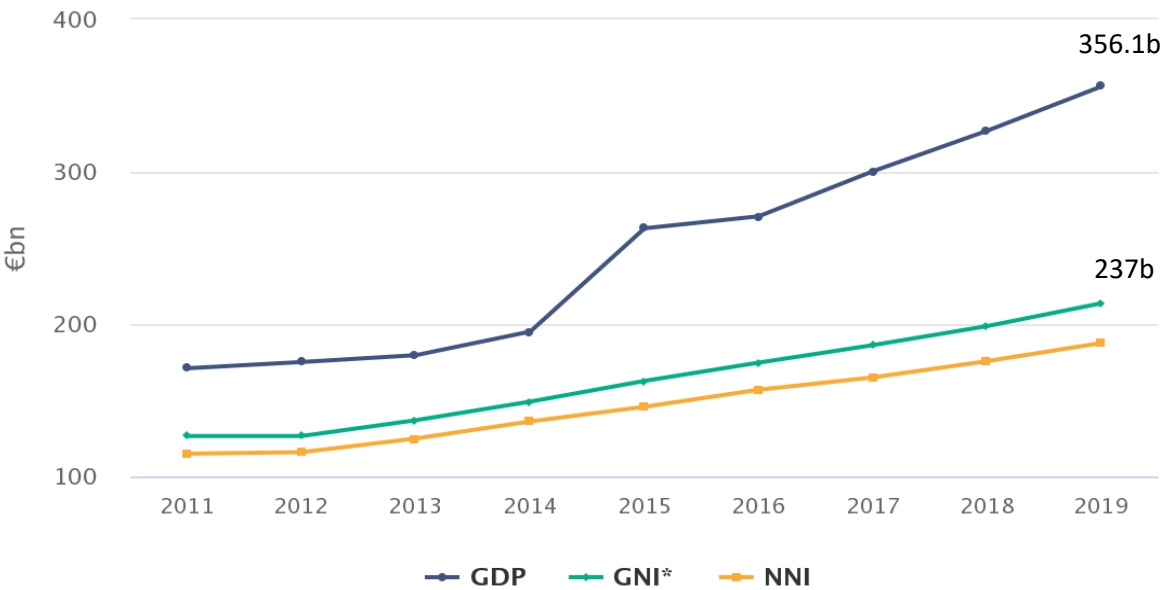
APPENDIX C: TOTAL INCOME RECORDED FROM SAMPLE
